#### Hearing aids.

As a retiree I found that spending my life running Lawn mowers and chainsaws and loud equipment resulted in my hearing changed and frequently "I say what did you say? Huh?" So, on the advice of a friend, I went to check out my hearing and as you can expect, it has declined a great deal. Consumer Report magazine had an article about hearing aids including those from Costco. I went to visit Costco and they gave me a hearing test for free. Showed me the results. And as an experiment while I was in the warehouse, they gave me a set to walk around the building. The hearing Tech called my cell phone and instantly I could hear the phone in both ears, very clearly, like I had not heard in years. Wow, I was thrilled. The hearing aids at Costco were only \$ 1500. for the pair, and I found that my insurance paid 80+% of the cost, my out-of-pocket costs were only \$200 for the pair. And they came with guarantees and warranties, so if I lose one, they'll replace it for free, step on it or break and they replace it for free, and when I'm near their store, they will check them for free, clean them, adjust them, put new pads on them, and the hearing aids are rechargeable so they do not need batteries. So, for me getting my hearing aids from Costco was a great Improvement. If you find yourself saying "what did you say" Costco may be a store to check out.


#### MEMBERSHIP AT THE CENTER

The Senior Center is a private corporation in the Soldotna area governed by a Board of Directors. It is not owned or managed by any city, borough, state or federal agency. The Center provides services by obtaining funding from sources including: city, borough, state and federal agencies, fundraisers such as bazaars, special dinners, \$5-or-more-a-month club members and seniors that pay an annual \$25 membership fee. Lifetime memberships are also available based on age.













#### **SENIOR CENTER SERVICES**

The Senior Center provides services to individuals age 60 and older, younger spouses of seniors, and others that are disabled may be eligible that live in senior housing where services are being provided or with an eligible senior. There are no income limits to attend. If you have questions about services, including assistance, referrals, home delivered meals, etc., come to the Center or call 262-2322.

#### **SENIOR BENEFITS PROGRAM**

We can provide applications for the Senior Benefits Program. You must be an Alaska resident age 65 or older. The chart at the bottom is your gross income before any deductions are subtracted (such as taxes or Medicare premiums). The Alaska Permanent Fund Dividend does NOT count as part of your gross income.
