For 2025, the May 2m Contest is now a 6 hour event on the first Sunday of a full weekend in May to co-ordinate with the European 2m contest that weekend but, with the 70cm Trophy on the Saturday, still offers a full weekend of RSGB VHF contests. The first Backpackers event has moved to align with this new May 2m contest slot NB: Modes allowed in RSGB VHF contests are only SSB, CW, FM, AM, JT6M, ISCAT & FSK441, except for dedicated MGM events when any MGM but not CW or EME Users of WSJT-X should enable EU VHF Contest mode; DO NOT USE the WSJT-X software dedicated Contest formats or Fox in Fox & Hounds mode.
