



It is with a sense of great sadness that I write this my final letter in the bulletin. Leaving of course is not my idea, but know that I leave with a full heart. It has been an absolute honor and a privilege to have been assigned here to serve and minister among so many wonderful people, among so many wonderful parishes. While I've only been here for a relatively short time, it feels like I've belonged here for my entire life.

As I reflect upon my time here, I cannot help but be overwhelmed by the countless blessings that our Heavenly Father has bestowed upon me. These past few days some have said to me, "Father, thank you for doing such and such for me and my family." I am humbled by their kindness, but in truth, it is I who need to thank you. May we continue to grow in faith and hope, so that Jesus Christ in the Most Holy Eucharist will truly be the source and summit of our lives.


