To Our Holy Cross Family Parishioners

Do you remember a newly ordained priest 15 years ago in his first assignment after ordination at what was then called the Coldwater Cluster of Parishes? Although he was from Minster, he was excited about serving the Church as a parochial vicar in such a good and wholesome area of Mercer County. Well, that same priest is back, sent by the archbishop, to continue his priestly work at what is now called the Holy Cross Family of Parishes. And I, Father Barry, am very excited and happy to be here.


A little about myself, since it's been a few years since I was last here. I grew up in a big family in Minster, played all the sports in high school, finished first in my class and went to college for engineering at GMI in Flint, Michigan. But God had a plan for my life. After college, I entered a religious order and spent time on the east coast, in Spain and in Rome, Italy. I left that order and came back to Ohio. Four years later, our Lord invited me to be a parish priest. The happiest day of my life came in 2009 when I was ordained a priest in Cincinnati. It's a great story, and I look forward to sharing with you again sometime.

So, I can attest that God certainly has His plans for our lives. Along the way, many things happen to us, we are put in difficult situations, we make mistakes, and we have to live with the consequences, always trying to see God's Will through it all. As you may know, twelve years ago in the first days of being a pastor, I made a mistake in handling a situation that was thrust upon me involving a former priest of that parish. It was a gut reaction to some very disturbing stuff. In no way was I trying to cover anything up. I wish I had handled it differently. I have learned from this situation and won't make that mistake again.

So, God's plan continues to unfold for me. I come back "up north", to God's country, where I grew up and where I have spent most of my priesthood. It feels like coming home again. I humbly promise to do all I can to serve you as one of the priests in this great family of parishes. I want to help you get to Heaven – that has always been the meaning of my priesthood – giving all glory to God through Jesus Christ. I hope you will accept me as your priest and together let's do great things for the Lord.


