Message from the Priests

Loving Your Mother? There's an App for That!

Advent is a time where Mary really pops into focus: we think about her giving birth to Jesus, about her and St. Joseph taking Him to the Temple for the Presentation, St. Simeon's prophetic utterances about the Mother and Child, just to name a few. It's never a bad time to love Mary and Jesus more, but this time of year is always an invitation to the incredibly powerful devotion of the Rosary.

The problem, though, is that a lot of people seem to be intimidated by the Rosary. And I get it: it's a long prayer; memorizing the mysteries was probably easier years ago; or maybe we were never taught to pray the Rosary or just never "got into it". As Padre Pio would say, "the Rosary is the weapon for these times". I want to encourage all of you to pray the Rosary as often as you can. Pope Blessed Pius IX would say, "Give me an army saying the Rosary, and I will conquer the world!" And boy, does the evil we see in this world need conquering! In addition, the Rosary is the sort of prayer that teaches you how to pray. I know a religious sister who is fond of saying that the Rosary is like "training wheels" for your prayer life! And yet, it's also deep enough that it can sustain even the deepest saints (St. John Paul II, one of the most brilliant men of our times, often said that his favorite prayer was the Rosary).

But how do you get started praying the Rosary?

"The Rosary is a powerful weapon to put the demons to flight and to keep oneself from sin... If you desire peace in your hearts, in your homes, and in your country, assemble each evening to recite the Rosary. Let not even one day pass without saying it, no matter how burdened you may be with many cares and labors." — Pope Pius XI

If you've struggled with praying the Rosary in the past, you're definitely not alone. There are a lot of resources out there to help people bring the Rosary into their lives. These resources range from pamphlets that have all the prayers in them, to books (like St. Louis de Montfort's Secrets of the Rosary), and even podcasts. School of Faith, run by my friend John Leyendecker, is one of those apps. It has everything from introduction, to how to pray the Rosary, to daily meditations on the Rosary, connecting the Rosary to our everyday life.

I hope you check it out and that it helps you to get into this incredibly powerful prayer.


