Sacrament of Matrimony

It is highly recommended to book the church when booking your reception hall. Also, since the marriage preparation process usually takes several months to complete, please contact the Family Office at least nine months in advance to start the marriage preparation process.

In order to fulfill that responsibility, the sponsor needs to be a practicing Catholic. This means that prayer, scripture, the sacraments and especially Mass are important priorities in his/her life. This also means that a sponsor needs to be a fully initiated Catholic who has received the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation, and, if married, was married in the Catholic Church.



CHRYSOLOGUS PRAY FOR US

Advice on How to Have the Best Lent Ever

I want you to have the best Lent ever this year! For many of us, Lent is a time where we might have some good ideas or aspirations, but sometimes due to lack of planning, we fall short. For others, Lent might feel like a bit of a let-down. Much like the new year, we expect it to be a time of growth in our faith only to get to Easter and realize that I've not grown as much as I wish I would have. To help you have a great Lent and to get the juices flowing on what your Lenten penance will be, I want to give you three pieces of advice:

1. Begin with the end goal in mind.

What is the Lenten penance all about? It's not just something that we do as Catholics because we want to suffer more. The purpose of a Lenten penance is to (a) help us to think of Christ, (b) unite us to His Passion and (c) help us live our lives more for God and less for this world. Think of penances you have done in years past: have they helped you to accomplish this threefold goal? If they haven't, then definitely don't pick those penances again!

Pick one from each category.

2. The three penances that the Church specifically highlights are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. But the best Lents that I've ever had were those Lents where I chose not one of those "big three", but something for each of them! The great bishop and doctor of the Church St. Peter Chrysologus (d. 450) once said:

There are three things, my brethren, by which faith stands firm, devotion remains constant, and virtue endures. They are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Prayer knocks at the door, fasting obtains, almsgiving receives[T]hese three are one, and they give life to each otherLet no one try to separate them; they cannot be separated. If you have only one of them or not all together, you have nothing. So if you pray, fast; if you fast, show mercy; if you want your petition to be heard, hear the petition of others. If you do not close your ear to others you open God's ear to yourself.

This advice from St. Peter ties in well with the third piece of advice I want to give you here.

3. Go harder than you think you can.

If you work out, then you're probably familiar with the concept of muscle hypertrophy. Basically, the more weight you lift, and as long as you periodically increase that weight so that you are progressively lifting more, the bigger your muscles will grow. If you lift well below what your muscles can reasonably handle or if you only stay at a certain amount of weight, your muscles will not grow larger. The same is true in the spiritual life. Oftentimes, we're afraid to do "too much", so we end up doing too little.

Sometimes we do the same things year after year without going deeper into our faith. In both cases, the result is the same: spiritual muscles do not grow! Remember though: it's not your strength that matters. As St. Paul wrote: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Phillipians 4:13)! Whatever penance you decide on, bring it to Him in prayer, ask Him for His feedback, listen for His voice, and ask Him to be your strength.

Updated Lent & Easter Information

LENTEN ABSTINENCE & FASTING — Because Lent is primarily a time of penance for Easter, it includes days of both fasting and abstinence from meat. Ash Wednesday, March 5, and Good Friday, April 18, are days of abstinence from meat and also days of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of **abstinence** binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of **fasting** binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (canons 97, 1252)





Saint of the Week - Saint Katharine Drexel

Born into Philadelphia society, Katharine was an infant when she lost her mother. Her father remarried and the couple taught their daughters that their wealth was a "gift on loan" to be shared with the poor, whom they fed and cared for in their home. Invited by priest-friends to witness firsthand the destitution on Native American reservations, Katharine resolved to devote her inheritance to this apostolate and enter a contemplative



order. When, however, in private audience, she begged Leo XIII to send missionaries to staff the schools she was building, the pope replied, "My child, why not become a missionary yourself?" Katharine renounced a twenty-million-dollar fortune and founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, adoring Christ present in the Eucharist and ministering to Christ suffering in victims of racial discrimination. Her Sisters established over sixty schools nationwide, including Xavier University, New Orleans, the first dedicated to professional education for African Americans. In 2000, John Paul II canonized "Mother Drexel," praising her "excellent example of practical charity and generous solidarity with the less fortunate, long the distinguishing mark of American Catholics." —Peter Scagnelli
