A Different Spin...

Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the Lenten season comes with a lot of promise and dare I say excitement to grow in our faith and personally take this spiritual stuff serious 🙄. What does that typically look like? Well, generally speaking we give something up that we like, but can live without 🍫🍪📺🍩🍷 and we might add something extra to help us feel closer to God. That's nice and honestly that's what I have done most of my life.

As I've thought about it, I'm not sure if I've ever really pondered deeply and scripturally the perennial teenage question of "Why do we have to do this???? 🧑🙄🧑" The answer is simply BECAUSE IT'S LENT and that's what we do...in Lent, right? SIR, YES, SIR 🙄. So prayer 🙏, fasting 🍷, and almsgiving 💰 are the 3 different categories provided by the Church to give and to grow during this penitential season. That is true and it's helpful, at least to get us started...

I'd like to propose a different spin on our next 40 days 🤔

What if the WHOLE POINT of Lent was to prepare for Pentecost?!? I know, I totally just lost you 🙄. What even is Pentecost and when are you going to use the ninja emoji??? Well... 🥷 there you go and Pentecost is the Feast where the Church celebrates the Holy Spirit raining 🌧️ fire 🔥 upon the Apostles in the Upper Room 50 days after Jesus' Resurrection aka Easter. At this moment the original crew of the apostles who followed Jesus did so with POWER ⚡ from HIGH ☁️. With courage and conviction they preached, they healed, they LIVED FAITH in GOD in a way that was magnetic 🧲 drawing thousands to become followers of Jesus 🧑. BUT before this moment even after they encountered Jesus risen 🧑 from the dead 🧟 they were not capable of giving any real witness. 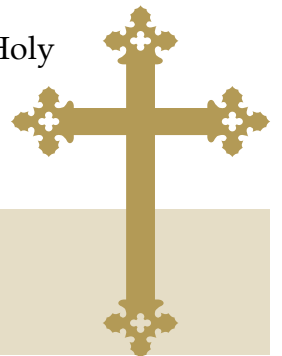

Saint of the Week - Saint Fina

God calls us to be saints no matter what our circumstances. Some young, some old, some rich, some poor, some in positions of power and some of humble means. Seraphina, or Fina for short, was just a child when God called her to demonstrate heroic virtue. She was a beautiful girl born into a poor family. After her father's death, she fell victim to a strange illness that paralyzed and misshaped her, making her unsightly, in constant pain and unable to move. Her mother was forced to leave her for hours at a time to work to provide for her family. Fina realized she was called to imitate Christ's suffering and clung to the crucifix for consolation. Then her mother also died and she had only one friend who visited her and brought her food. She had a special devotion to Pope St. Gregory the Great, and often asked for his intercession. He appeared to her one week before her death and told her that God would give her rest on his feast day (March 12). The whole city, who had abandoned her during her time of need due to her illness and physical appearance, attended her funeral and began to pray to her. Her neighbors found white violets at her resting place and to this day the white violets that bloom in March are called St. Fina flowers. She was only fifteen years old when she died. May we all learn from the example of St. Fina to be patient in bearing our own crosses and draw strength from the sufferings of Jesus to endure them. — Tami Urcia
