#### **Finishing Strong**

Years ago, I used to run half marathons. I stopped running a few years ago because, while I was training for the Flying Pig in Cincinnati, I overtrained and hurt my knee. It wasn't the worst knee injury imaginable: I can still run if I need to, but if I try to do so consistently, I need to wear a knee brace. Furthermore, this was my right knee, my genuflecting knee! After praying about it, I decided to hang up my running shoes for good. I do other things to stay in shape, but I need that knee to reverence the Lord more than I need it to run.

To be honest, if I hadn't overtrained my knee, I'd still be running today. I loved it. I loved the challenge and the way it made me feel. Most of all, I loved the process of needing to be mentally disciplined enough to get a new personal record. Right when you were thinking about giving up or slowing up, that was the moment to dig deeper and keep going.

I've joked in the past that I look forward to Lent like most people look forward to Christmas. But part of why I love Lent so much is because this is our chance to pursue that "more excellent self". Who could I become if I followed these Lenten disciplines



I'm taking on? Could I become more dedicated to prayer? Could I be less attached to food through fasting? Could I know more truly in my heart that my true treasure is in Heaven through almsgiving? For me, there's always that sense of the possibility of being so much better and more dedicated to the Lord that's calling my name. The Lord calls us all to become saints, but a saint isn't someone who's perfect. A saint is someone who is fighting sin and pursuing virtue. A saint is someone who is actively--not passively--allowing him or herself to be perfected by God's grace.


But there's always that time in Lent when it's starting to feel like a lot. The same temptation to give up or slow up that I would feel while running is always going to appear during Lent for all of us. For some people, it's near the beginning: we do something for a day or two (if that!) and then realize how hard it is. Others experience that temptation towards the middle: things get in the way, life is always calling and distracting me. Personally, I always experience this temptation towards the end of Lent: I've put in a few good weeks, made some growth, maybe that's good enough...

It's not a matter of if the temptation to give up or slow up is going to come, it's a matter of when. But whenever we experience that temptation, we know it's our time to dig in and cling more firmly to the Lord. Even if you feel like you've already given up or slowed up this Lent, don't let anything stop you from finishing strong!

In order to fulfill that responsibility, the sponsor needs to be a practicing Catholic. This means that prayer, scripture, the sacraments and especially Mass are important priorities in his/her life. This also means that a sponsor needs to be a fully initiated Catholic who has received the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation, and, if married, was married in the Catholic Church.







#### Saint of the Week - St. Stanislaus

Have you ever had to confront evil or injustice? Have you ever tried to reason with those who could not see reason, or share your faith with those who were not open to God? I remember a few episodes in high school where I would ask those around me not to use foul language or when I chose to disassociate with those who were known to drink, smoke or act promiscuously. But all of this pales in comparison to what Stanislaus went through.



He was born near Kraków, Poland in 1030. He was ordained a priest, became known for his preaching and holy example, and was ordained bishop of Kraków in 1072. He was known for his boldness and spoke out against unjust wars, immorality and other evils. Preceding Thomas More and Thomas Becket, all three of them vigorously opposed the evils of unjust government, even to the point of standing up to the king. King Boleslaus killed Stanislaus himself, after the saintly bishop excommunicated him due to his evil ways. May we learn from the example of Saint Stanislaus to boldly proclaim the truth, no matter what the cost. — Tami Urcia


