#### The Family Rosary

You've probably heard the phrase: "the family that prays together, stays together"! A great way to pray together as a family has always been the Family Rosary. This has been something that more and more families have been expressing an interest in and that we want to encourage families to consider, but the problem with praying the Family Rosary is that it never seems to go as well as planned!

When parents think about starting to pray the Family Rosary together, they think the only way it counts is if their kids are completely silent or praying along (nicely!) the entire time; that the kids have to be sitting or kneeling completely still the entire time; and



that there can be no complaining involved. They want to pray the Family Rosary, but then they look at their kids and think: there's no way we could do that!

But if you're a parent who's interested in praying the Rosary as a family there's one thing you need to know: **It doesn't have to be perfect!** It's allowed to be messy and chaotic...sacrifices generally are! Here are three strategies to help your family start to pray the Rosary together:

The Fireplace Rosary: Mom or dad pray the Rosary out loud while kids have "quiet time". Kids can color pictures (maybe even a picture of Jesus, Mary, or one of the mysteries of the Rosary) or read/page through a book about a saint or a children's Bible. As they get older and want to join in, they can. The idea of this strategy is to just make the Family Rosary like a cozy fire: sit there, relax, and enjoy the time together!

The Divide-and-Conquer Rosary: As part of the bedtime routine, parents pray just a single decade of the Rosary with the kid they are putting to bed. I'd suggest doing it just after reading them a bedtime story. If they can stay awake and quiet through the decade of the Rosary, then maybe they can talk about a second story! Once the kids are down, mom, dad, and any older kids can just pray whatever's still remaining of the Rosary together.

*The On-The-Go Rosary:* Even as an adult, I struggle to sit still and pray the Rosary. My favorite way to pray is while I'm walking or driving. It gives me a great excuse to get some fresh air and enjoy God's beauty in nature. If I'm in the car, there's a 99% chance that the Rosary is going to be a better use of my car ride than whatever's on the radio. You can even get audio files/podcasts of the Rosary if you want.

But at the end of the day, the only wrong answer to "how to pray as a family" is not praying. Remember, especially if you have little kids, that God created them to be messy, squirmy, and loud. Embrace that as part of the sacrifice and--in the words of St. Padre Pio--Pray, hope, and just don't worry!

#### Saint of the Week - Saint John Paul II, Pope

On October 16, 1978, Cardinal Karol Wojtyla, Archbishop of Krakow, was elected the 263<sup>rd</sup> successor to Saint Peter and chose the name John Paul II in honor of the late John Paul I. Pope John Paul II was the first ever Slavic pope elected, and at 58-years-old, he was youngest pope in over a century. During his twenty-six-year pontificate, he visited over 129 countries, which included seven visits to the United States. He died on April 2, 2005, beatified in St. Peter's Square on May 1, 2011, by Pope Benedict XVI, and canonized on April 27, 2014, by Pope Francis. 
