# Message from the Priests

## Travel Plans and Prayer Plans

During the month of June, you might not see me as much. For much of the month, I will be in Colorado, working with college students through the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). The program I will be helping with is called Summer Projects and it is not a traditional mission trip. Summer Projects allows students to work--usually at a resort or a park--for the duration of the summer. They work 40+ hours and get paid for that work. They often learn new skills and gain helpful experience along with it. But all of this is just an excuse for the real work. Summer Projects is a chance for them to live in community with other Catholic students where they will have access to daily Mass, spiritual coaching, Adoration, Confession, Bible studies, and more. In essence, Summer Projects allows them to continue to grow in their spiritual life while giving them the chance to save up money, gain experience, and make lasting memories.

To make this happen, priests from around the country will commit to being on site with the students. We work together to provide two opportunities per day for Mass, Adoration, and Confession (because some students work mornings and some work evenings). Throughout the day, the chaplains are available to the students for spiritual coaching where we walk them through the next steps of their spiritual journey, providing feedback and advice. That's where I come in. Usually, the days are long and packed, beginning early in the morning and lasting late into the night--it's an apostolate for college students after all! But every year, even though I return tired and worn out, wondering if I'm too old for this...it is an incredible opportunity that I am deeply grateful to be a part of.

I hope that you will pray for me and the students and missionaries I will serve. But I also want you to know that a day doesn't go by where I don't think about you all back home. More importantly, there isn't a day that goes by without prayers for you all. Without wanting to violate Jesus' warning in Matthew 6:6, I want you to know that among other things during this time away:

--I pray for all of my parishes, especially for spiritual protection, for you all when I pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

--I am fasting everyday during this trip for the continuing sanctification of my parishioners.

--I remember you all during the Mass and will offer a Mass for each of the churches individually.

--I frequently ask the students to pray a decade of the Rosary for my parishes as a penance in Confession.

--I continue to offer Mass on the first Tuesday of the month for families, especially those struggling with difficult pregnancies, infertility, or miscarriage.

A lot of this is for all of you "in general", but I will frequently pray for those that pop into my mind or if I know of particular needs/intentions. But to do this more intentionally, I want to end with an invitation: if there is anything in particular that you would like me to pray for: please email me ([fr.witt.aoc@gmail.com](mailto:fr.witt.aoc@gmail.com)). If you are reading this on our social media and feel comfortable, you can also post those intentions in the comments and I will ask the staff to keep me updated.

You are always in my prayers, not just during my trip. Please pray for me, too, especially that I may grow in holiness and be ready for Heaven at the end of my life.

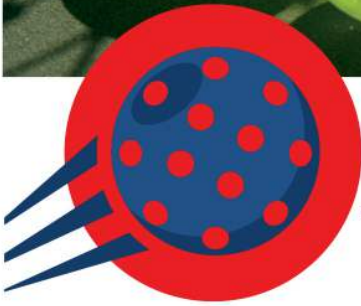

### FROM THE BUSINESS MANAGER

— We are budgeting our Parish Permanent Improvement fund (PPI Envelopes and PPI Online giving) to address three major projects within the next 5 years. ## Saint of the Week - St. Ephrem

He was born in present-day Turkey, the son of a pagan priest and a Christian mother. From a very young age, he displayed an explosive temper, which he learned to control. At a very young age, he was baptized and later ordained a deacon. His ministry was dedicated to teaching the faith, for he was a great teacher. His bishop, noting his Christian and human qualities, wanted to ordain



him a priest, but Ephrem opposed it, considering the priesthood unworthy of him. As a deacon and teacher, he spread Christian teaching with extraordinary writing skills, making use of poetry, religious songs, and parodying the lyrics of popular songs of his time to not only refute Christian heresies but also to propagate the teachings of Christ. History distinguishes him with the nickname "The Zither of the Holy Spirit." Through his poetry, he founded a theological school. Although he did not speak Greek, he was bold in his language, writing poems dedicated to Mary, Mother of God. His writings and mysticism made him one of the Doctors of the Church.—Miguel Arias
