Here are some ways YOUR membership helps support Happy Tails:

Trap/Neuter/Release (TNR) Program

In 2023, we spent \$13,211.15 trapping, spaying/neutering, and releasing eighty-three feral cats within our community. The TNR program helps to stop the breeding cycle of cats and ensures no new kittens are born, stabilizes cat populations, provides vaccines, and improves cat's lives.

SNAP (Spay, Neuter Assistance Program)

In 2023, we spent \$1,276.20 on our SNAP Program. This program is offered to residents of Dawson County and provides funds to help cover the costs of spaying or neutering their cat and helps prevent unwanted/abandoned litters.

Pet Food Pantry

Happy Tails established the Pet Food Pantry in 2019 to help residents in the community struggling to feed their pets. We hold multiple food drives throughout the year, and we work with our local food pantry to dispense the food.

Vaccine Clinic

We partner with our local Vet Clinic to provide free and/or low-cost vaccines for both cats and dogs in our community.

Microchip Clinic

We provide a low-cost Microchip Clinic so that in the event a pet owner's cat or dog goes missing, they can be tracked by their microchip.

Your membership also provides food, vaccines, medical care, and shelter to the many other unwanted or abandoned cats within our community. In 2023, we spent \$19,819.12 on veterinary care alone for the cats in the rescue.

In 2023, we were able to purchase a much-needed larger space for the rescue with running water.
