

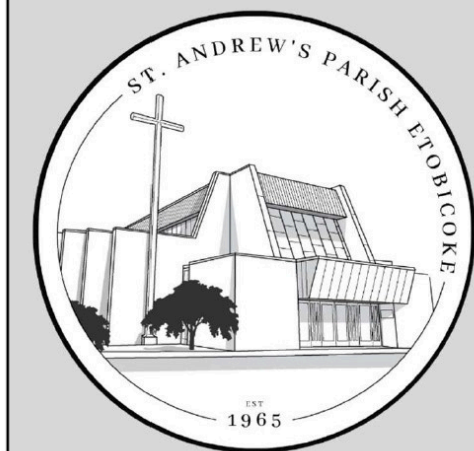

Rite of Initiation of Adults into the Christian Faith. Interested in becoming a Catholic? Please contact the Pastor.

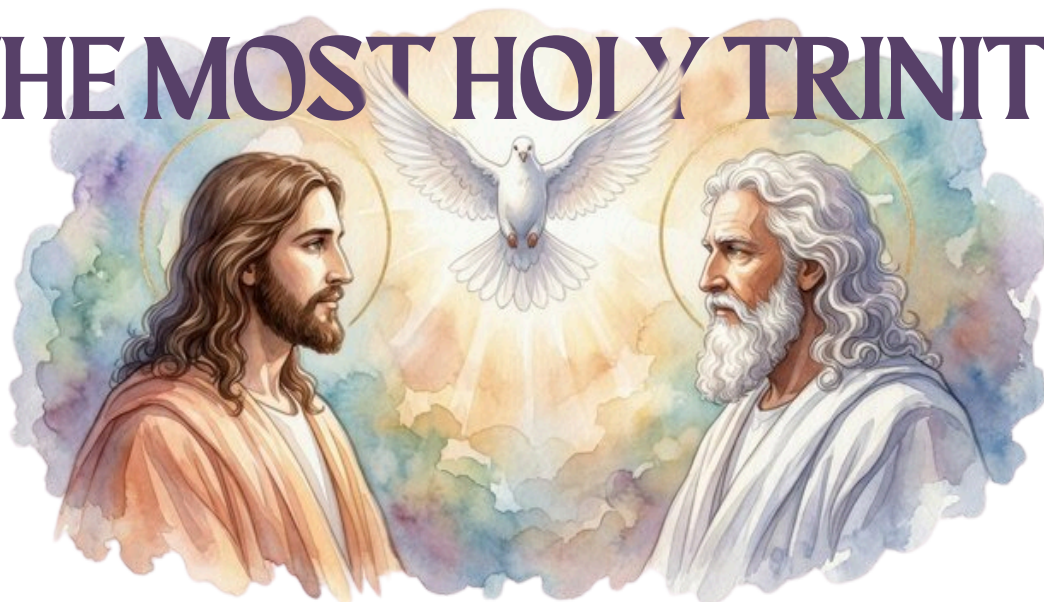
## NEW PARISHIONER? BE MOST WELCOME!
