## Things to Bring for Your Child's Field Trip

To ensure a safe, hygienic, and enjoyable experience, please prepare the following items for your child:

- Socks – Required for all adults and children entering the presentation room (for hygiene purposes)
- Water Bottle – To stay hydrated
- Mosquito Repellent – Recommended for outdoor comfort
- Cap or Hat – For sun protection
- Coins or Small Notes – For vending machine & On site purchases
- Light Snacks – Optional; only dry snacks are allowed
- (No bento sets, rice, or noodles please)

## On-Site Purchases (Optional)

Enhance your child's experience with these optional take-home items:

### Fish Theme:

- Fish Food – \$1.50 per pack (to feed your own fishes at home)
- LED Light (for Fish Tank) – \$3.80 (1 set of 2)

### All related Plant Theme:

- Standing Grow Light – \$12 each (to support your child's plant at home)

### Facilities Available On-Site:

- Water Cooler (Hot & Cold) (Free for all teachers and students to use)
- Vending Machine (Coin & Note operated)

### Toilets:

- Separate male and female toilets are available.
- Each toilet has approximately 4 cubicles.

Please note: Diaper-changing tables are not available on site.

### Arrival Time Requirement:

All school groups are required to arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled event time for preparation and smooth check-in.

## Important Note for Parents & Teachers

Please be informed that the experience takes place in a farm environment, and it may be warm depending on the weather. We encourage parents to dress their children comfortably and ensure they are well-prepared with sun protection and hydration if needed.

Kindly note that this field trip is specially designed as a hands-on, experiential learning activity for children. As such, the program is not structured for parental participation, and we seek your understanding in allowing the children to engage independently under the guidance of our facilitators and teachers.

### Fire Evacuation Plan:

In case of fire or emergency, all facilitators, children, and guests must evacuate immediately and follow staff instructions.

### Designated Assembly Points:

1. Open Carpark Area (within the premises)
2. Open Plant Nursery Area (adjacent to the activity zone)

### Responsibilities:

- Teachers/facilitators must guide and stay with their groups.
- Conduct a full headcount at the assembly point.
- Await clearance before re-entering any facility.

## **Bus Drop-off Instructions:** (Inform Bus driver & Teachers)



### **For Events With Parents (e.g., PG and N1 Levels):**

- Buses are required to drop off outside the main entrance of Nature Kindred.
- Children and parents will walk approximately 20 steps into the premises, where our staff will receive them.
- If buses are required to enter, only one enter at a time. **(Subject to time availability)**
- Please do not block the entrance or traffic flow during drop-off or pick-up.

**In any case if its rain: Please ensure the bus door faces the restaurant/café side as close as possible**



### **For Events Without Parents (e.g., N2, K1, K2):**

- Buses are required to enter the premises to drop off the children near the cafe.
- Only one bus is allowed inside the premises at a time to prevent congestion.
- Do not block the entrance or internal roadways.

**In any case if its rain: Please ensure the bus door faces the restaurant/café side as close as possible**
