

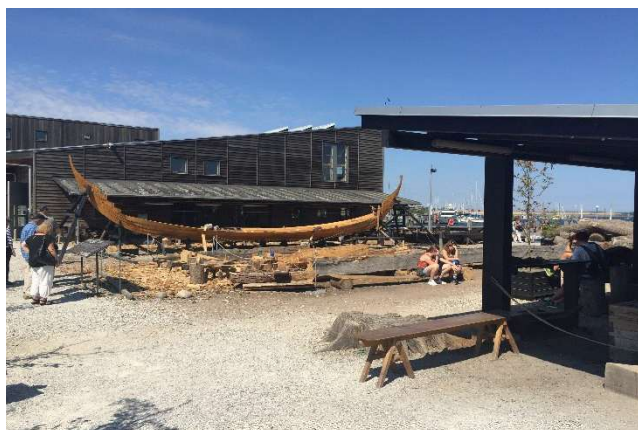
Experience Denmark - travel through history FROM VIKINGS TO DEMOCRATS

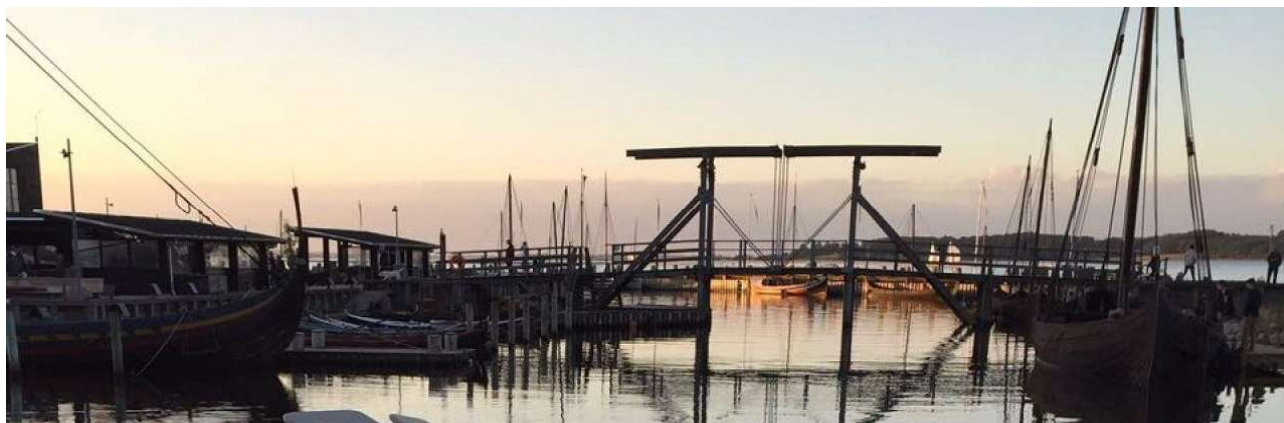

PERIOD:

18. - 19. July - Arrival weekend with family stay
 20. - 31. July - Camp period with events
 01. - 02. August - Departure weekend with family stay

PARTICIPANTS:

A total of 9 boys and 9 girls may attend (max. 1 girl and 1 boy from the same country).
 Participants must be between the ages of 16 and 18 years old.
 Participants must speak English.



ARRIVAL:

Upon your arrival by air or train, a Rotarian will meet you at the airport/train station.

BASE CAMP:

You will be located in the Bjarke Group Scout Camp in Roskilde when not attending outdoor activities. You will be sleeping in bunk beds in a room for 9 boys and a room for 9 girls. Remember to bring a sleeping bag.

CAMP RULES:

You shall accept the Rotary rules for youth exchange. Moreover you arrange and pay for your own travel costs to and from Denmark yourself, as well as health, risk and third-party liability insurance and pocket money.
