## 12th July (Saturday) Visit to Igualada and surroundings

In the morning we will go hiking in Montserrat, a rocky massif traditionally considered the most important and significant mountain in Catalonia.

Also known as “The Magic Mountain”, it is the cradle of legends and traditions from ancient times and a must-see pilgrimage destination. It is home to the Montserrat monastery, a Benedictine abbey dedicated to the “Mare de Déu de Montserrat”, popularly known as “La Moreneta”.

We will climb “Sant Jeroni” from where we can contemplate spectacular 360° views.

Lunch on the mountain.

Arrival in Igualada at around 5:00 p.m., rest with the family and reunions at dinner time.

Afterwards we will attend the “Night glow festival”, the most important balloon gathering in southern Europe.

More than 50 teams gather in Igualada and we will enjoy a fabulous show.
