ACCOMODATION: At Rotarian homes before and after the sailing trip as well as on board the ship "Jensine" (2nd week from August 3rd to 10th).

INSURANCE: The guests are expected to bring their own insurance (health, risks and accidents).

COSTS: The guests pay for their own trip to/from via Billund Airport (or Vojens Train Station in Southern Jutland), from where pick-up will be arranged. All other expenses are paid for by the Rotary Clubs, but we advise the guests to bring their own pocketmoney. Further a participation fee **€uro 150** Euro will be charged.
