We will also explore the regional natural beauties, castles and other tourist attractions during several hikes. Canoeing on the rivers in Czech is very popular during the summer, that is why the participants will have a chance to try out this fun activity also.

Visit to Prague is a must and we will dedicate one full-day trip to the extraordinary beauties of our capital exploring not only the famous sights, but also many hidden gems.

We will dine in rotarian families, in the local restaurants or in nature while hiking and canoeing.

We will spend the weekend in the mountains — Sumava national park mountain lodge.

The second part of the summer camp will be hosted by RC Pisek. We will have a chance to get to know the rich history of this beautiful city. Visits to other picturesque towns and tourist attractions will be part of the program. Participants can also look forward to biking trips around the Pisek region, admiring the surrounding natural and historical heritage.
