EnviraBoard's production technology, including the formula and process for handling raw materials and secondary paper sludge waste, has been developed over decades through extensive research, testing, pilot plant operation, and large-scale production. During earlier full-scale manufacturing, the boards were tested by independent institution and successfully obtained ETA certification.

Today, EnviraBoard is operating with third-generation technology. A patent application was submitted in December 2024, and this has since been extended through a Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) application, providing protection across 158 countries. The international application will mature into a range of regional and national applications, and we intend to pursue full patent protection in those jurisdictions that align with the development of our markets. Subject to grant and ongoing maintenance, patent protection may remain in force for up to 20 years from filing, i.e. until December 2045.

The PCT is an international treaty that simplifies the process of seeking patent protection in multiple countries with one "international" patent application.
