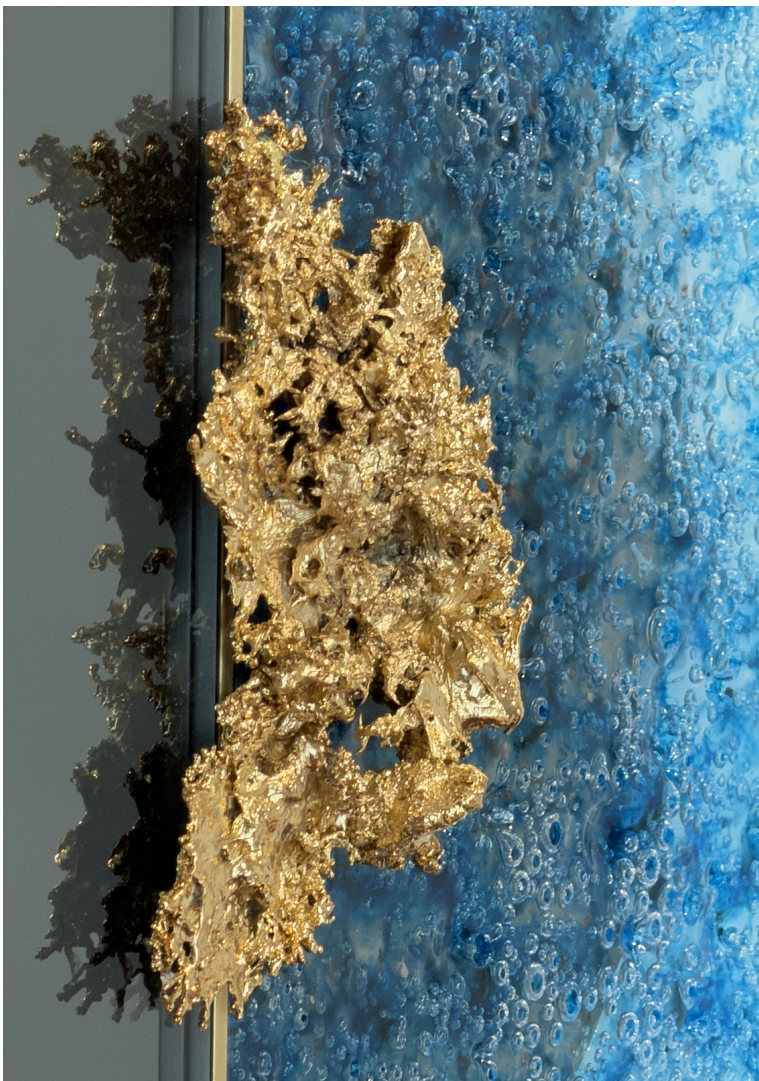
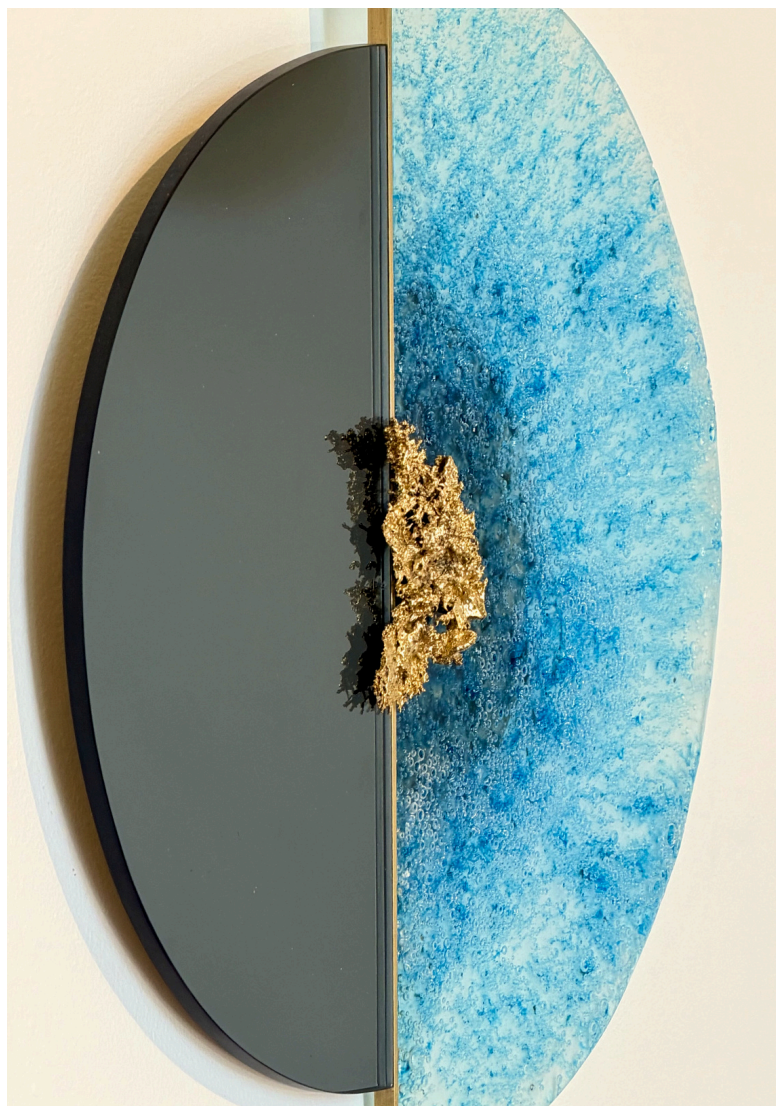
Hestia Gallery curates vintage historical pieces, and contemporary sculpturals, furniture, lighting, and artworks, all unique or crafted in limited series.

# Murdiya

by Yassine Meknache

For his exhibition at Le 19M by Maison Chanel, Yassine Meknache created a monumental six-meter tapestry in collaboration with exceptional women embroiderers in Morocco. Combining traditional embroidery with abstract painting, the work reflects a dialogue between craftsmanship, memory, and contemporary gesture.





Yassine Mekhnache develops a practice that moves between painting, textile, and gesture. Born in Lyon in 1979, he began with street graffiti before evolving toward a more abstract and meditative visual language. Since 2007, he has collaborated with embroiderers in Morocco and artisans in India

Influenced by Sufi philosophy and The Conference of the Birds, Mekhnache approaches abstraction as a journey rather than an image. His works explore memory, movement, and transformation through layered materials and expressive marks.

His work has been shown internationally at institutions and biennales including the Palais de Tokyo, the Dakar Biennale, and exhibitions in Paris, Casablanca, and New York. A retrospective at Le 19M / Chanel in 2023 highlighted his ongoing dialogue between contemporary painting and traditional craftsmanship.

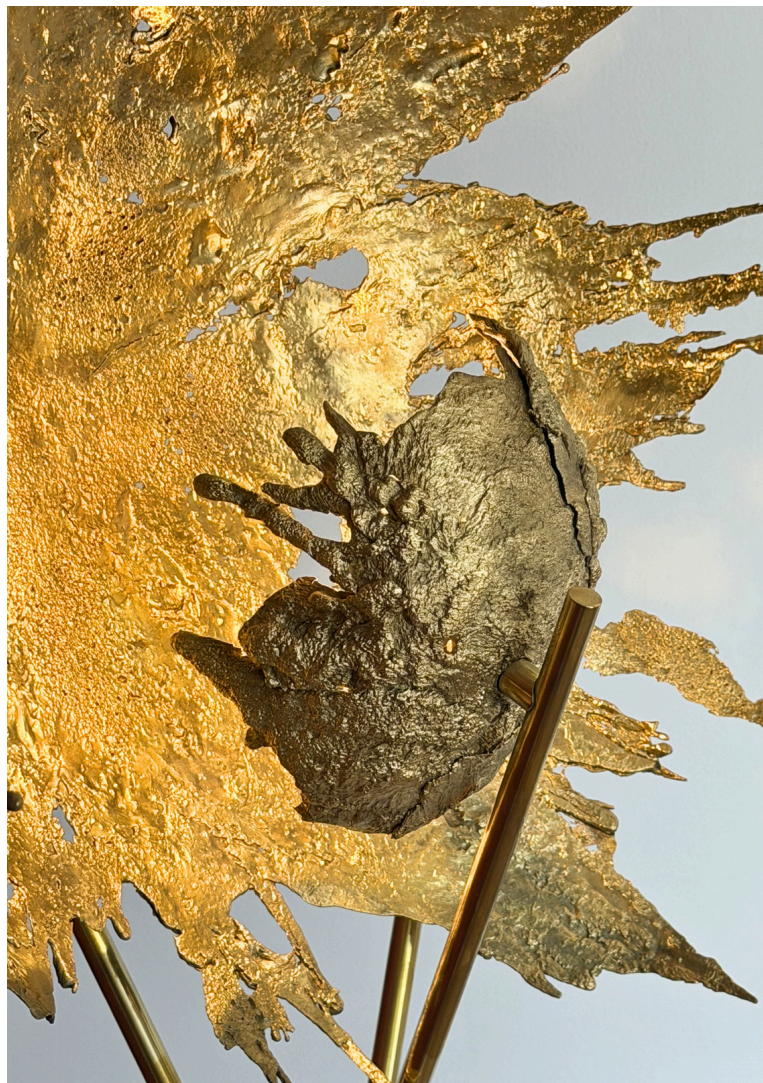

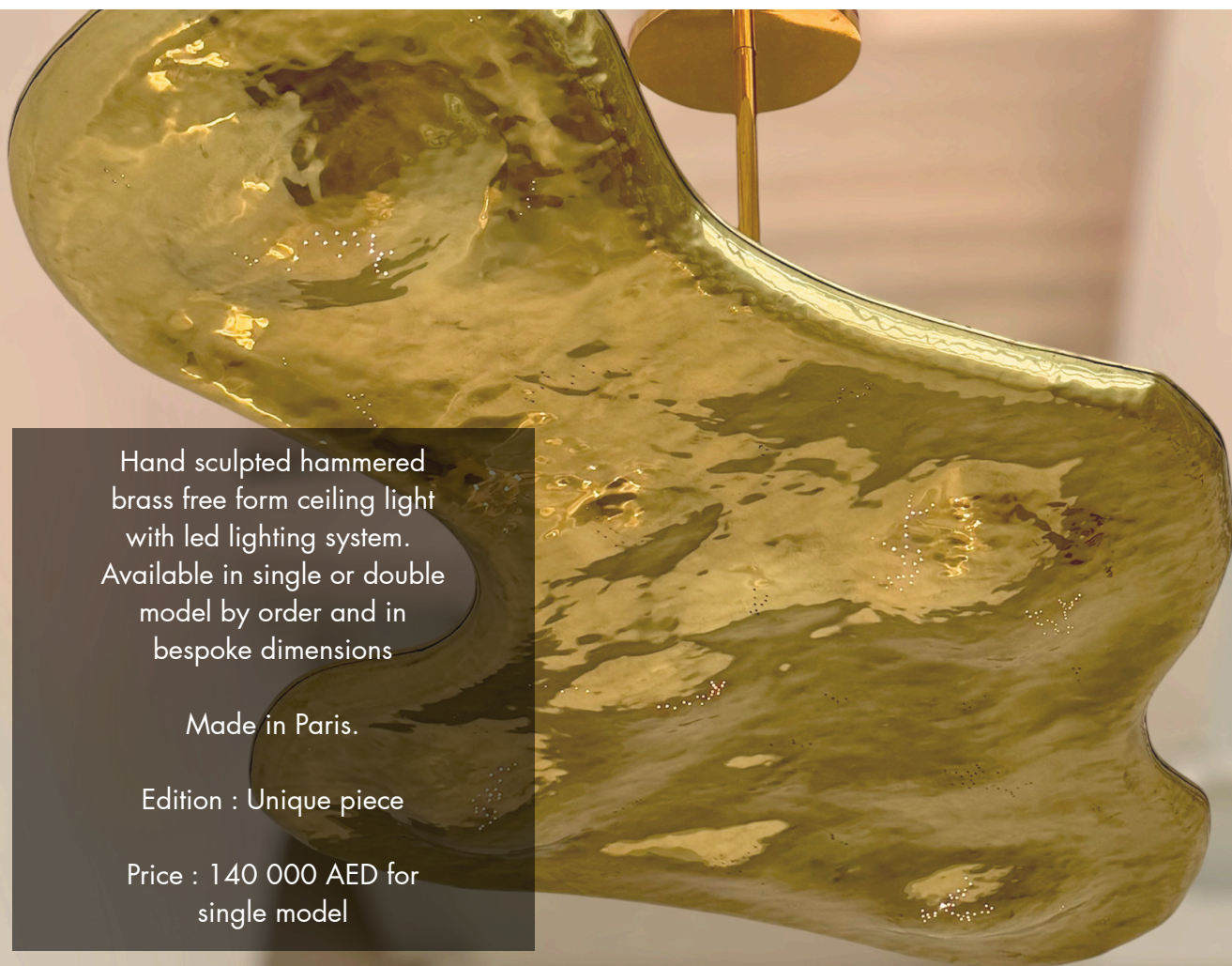
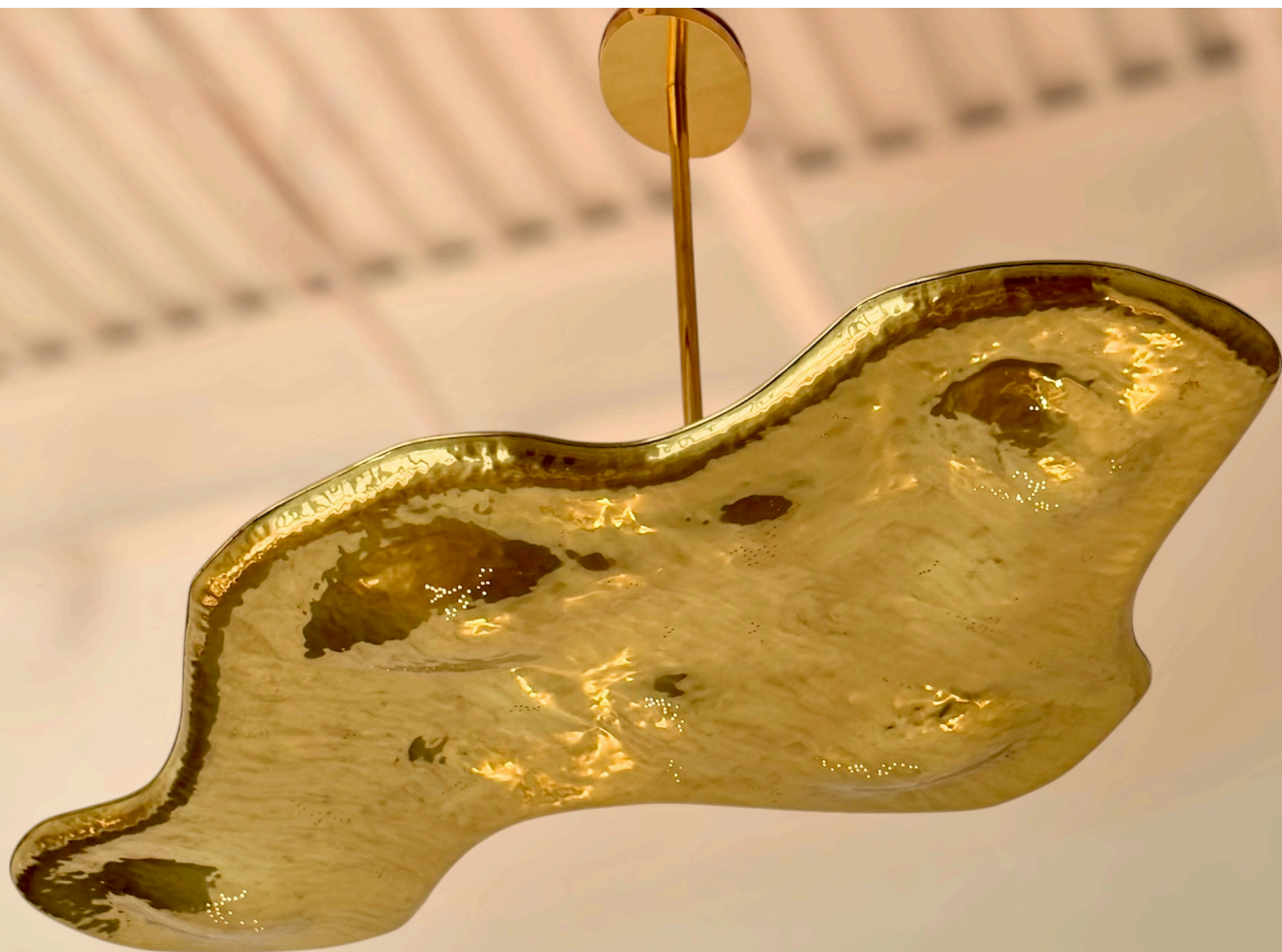
## Installation, CELESTIAL CLOUD

## About Alicia Peñalba

Alicia Peñalba is born in 1913 in San Pedro, Province of Buenos Aires (Argentina).

After moving to Paris in 1948, she abandons painting to devote herself exclusively to sculpture; she works for three years in the workshop of Ossip Zadkine at the Large Thatched Cottage. In 1952, Alicia Peñalba shows her work in numerous community events and Salons in Paris (Salon of Young Sculpture, New Realities Salon, International Exhibition of Rodin Museum, various biennials, etc.). Her works are also shown in solo exhibitions, the first being held in Paris in 1957.

Her work forms part of the collections of the Centre Pompidou (Paris); the Brooklyn Museum and the Schulhof Collection (New York); the Dallas Museum of Fine Arts; the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden (Washington, DC); Fondation Pierre Gianadda (Martigny, Switzerland); Zentrum Paul Klee (Berne, Switzerland); Rijksmuseum Kröller-Müller (Otterlo, the Netherlands)

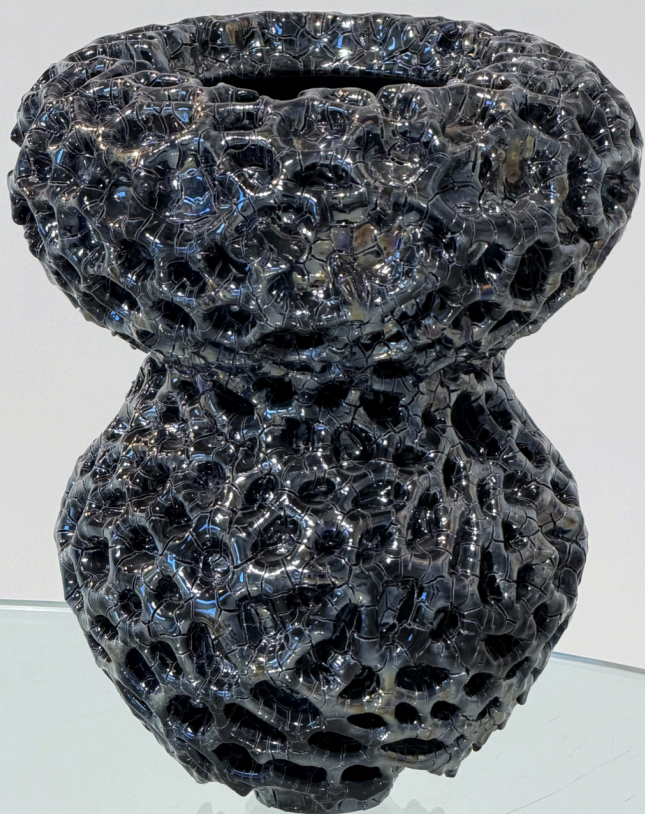

## Grand vol roux

A 1973 tapestry by Robert Wogensky :

Robert Wogensky (1919–2020) was a French artist and tapestry designer known for his lyrical abstract compositions. A student of the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris and a key figure at the Manufacture des Gobelins, he contributed to the revival of modern tapestry in the mid-20th century, blending subtle color harmonies with refined geometric forms. Made in Aubusson Aubusson, a town in central France, has been celebrated for its tapestry weaving since the 17th century. Recognized by UNESCO as part of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity, Aubusson tapestries are prized for their exceptional craftsmanship, fine wool and silk work, and artistic collaboration with painters and designers. Over the centuries, the Aubusson workshops have produced masterpieces that blend tradition and innovation, securing their place as a symbol of French decorative art.
