Instructions (Applicants/Senior Naval Science Instructors)

1. Visit our website: <https://www.tuskegee.edu/nrotc>
2. Click on "Apply" banner at the top of the screen.
3. Applicants: Download the Tuskegee NPP Application zip folder, save the forms locally to your computer.
4. Senior Naval Science Instructors (or other JROTC) (if applicable): Save the Senior Naval Science Instructor recommendation form locally to your computer.
5. Open the forms in Adobe Reader. Adobe Reader is available free from this website: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
6. Start typing your information into the document. Note: write your essays in Microsoft Word first so that you can spell check them, then cut and paste them into the application. Max allowed essay length is approximately one page, single-spaced in Microsoft Word. Ensure your entire essay is visible in the form when printed.
7. When complete, print and sign form using pen.
8. Applicants: Scan the signed document and forward it along with all other required documents (see checklist above) to LT Williams at jwilliams3@tuskegee.edu AND navalrotc@tuskegee.edu.
9. Senior Naval Science Instructors: scan and send signed document to jwilliams3@tuskegee.edu AND navalrotc@tuskegee.edu.

Applicants may be placed on an alternate list OR waiting list for the scholarship. Scholarships may be awarded up to an applicant's Freshman Spring semester.

31 JAN – Applications are due.

01 FEB -15 FEB – Interviews will be conducted.

01 MAR (estimated) – Scholarship awardees will be notified.
