In addition, this year we had a few new members added to our motley gang, whom the girls titled the "camp husbands." Both Cara's husband and my husband joined us in the evenings for a few hours. They helped tremendously, making dinner, cleaning the dishes and even crafting a makeshift camp oven in which the girls baked a cake.

To add to the new adventures that occurred during the week, the girls worked together to craft drills that they performed at the end of the week. They worked so well together as they shared thoughts, led one another and brought

together some truly amazing drills. Although each girl was exhausted, they still showed a tremendous amount of patience and kindness to their fellow participants.

Although the Adventure Program looked very different this year, God still used each adventure to show His faithfulness. We were each given strength to help, and the patience we needed to learn more about Him and to care for one another. The girls and the "camp husbands" gave support that Cara and I did not even know we needed. Much laughter was shared, much teamwork took place, and above all, God was glorified through the growth and grace shown by each person involved in the Adventure Program.
