On July 16, 2025, at its Annual Communication, the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge, State of Washington and Jurisdiction, elected and installed Most Worshipful Antonio D. Graham as its 51st Grand Master of Masons.

Most Worshipful Graham is the son of the late Sister Dorothy Thompson, Right Worshipful Mack Graham, Jr., and Kathy Graham. He was born into a large and loving multi-generational family in Benton Harbor, Michigan. His upbringing, along with his parents, was supported by Antonio's Grandmothers, Lillie Mae Thompson and Mary Graham, the matriarchs of the family. They showered Antonio with unconditional love and affection, encouragement, and guidance. As a result of his Father's service in the United States Army, Antonio also called Heidelberg, Germany, Lakewood, Washington, and Atlanta, Georgia home.

He was raised to the Degree of a Master Mason on May 4, 1992, in Beehive Military Lodge No. 66, Camp Humphry, Korea, F&A.M., Oklahoma Jurisdiction. While serving in the military, Most Worshipful Graham became a graduate of Supervision Management from Central Texas College. After twenty years of honorable service, Most Worshipful Graham retired as a Sergeant First Class.

Following his military retirement in 2007, Most Worshipful Graham returned to the great state of Washington, where he learned the true meaning of brotherly and sisterly love after he demitted into Lee Grant Rogers Lodge No. 61. That same year, he successfully secured employment as a Deputy with the Pierce County Sheriff's Department, where he continues to serve.

Most Worshipful Graham's Masonic journey is a testament to the unwavering support of his family. His Parents, Mack and Kathy Graham, his Wife, Michele, his Daughters, Jazmyne, Zana, and Antoinette, and his Son, Antonio, Jr., stand by him, providing the strength and encouragement he needs to fulfill his duties.
