Right Worshipful Christopher P. Moore Grand Lecturer

On July 16, 2025, during its 122nd Annual Communication, the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Washington and Jurisdiction elected and installed Right Worshipful Christopher P. Moore as its Grand Lecturer.

Right Worshipful Moore, the son of Norvell and Eloise Moore, was born in Blytheville, Arkansas, and is a 1992 Honor Graduate of Blytheville High School. He earned a Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration from Morehouse College in 1996. Following graduation, he spent the next decade in the telecommunications industry, serving in several senior project management roles.

In the fall of 2005, he enrolled in Clark Atlanta University's Graduate School of Business, where he earned an MBA with a concentration in Marketing in 2007. Upon graduation, he joined The Home Depot corporate headquarters in Atlanta, Georgia, as an Operations Analyst.

In the spring of 2009, his career took him to Portland, Oregon, and later to Seattle, Washington, where he spent the next sixteen years in progressive supply chain and marketing leadership roles within the technology industry, serving at both Intel Corporation and Microsoft Corporation.

Right Worshipful Moore has a deep and abiding love for fraternalism, a passion first inspired by his father, who introduced him to Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. throughout his childhood. He became a Spring 1995 initiate of the fraternity while attending Morehouse College. Shortly after his initiation, a chance meeting with a Brother who spoke to him about Freemasonry ignited a spark that would later lead him to knock on the door of Eden Lodge #46 in Marietta, Georgia, under the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Georgia. He was raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason on August 23, 2002, and later became a Charter Member of Foundation Lodge #592, located in Smyrna, Georgia.

Outside his professional and fraternal commitments, Right Worshipful Moore is a lifelong martial artist. He has held a Black belt in Tae Kwon Do for thirty-four years, as well as a brown belt in Judo and a blue belt in Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu.

He believes the tenets of Masonry are woven into the very fabric of his being and strives each day to contribute to the betterment of the Craft. He lives by the words of his fellow Morehouse College Alumnus, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.: **"Don't just set out to do a good job.
