Additionally, all Worshipful Masters who will have submitted candidates to be raised are required to attend the Grand Raising.

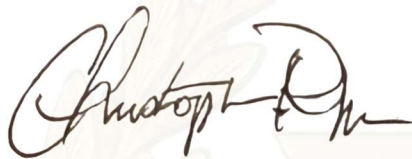
Brothers interested in serving on the Past Master's Degree Team (*Past Masters only*) and/or the Grand Raising Degree Team are encouraged to contact me
