Hotel's room rates are subject to applicable state and local taxes (currently 12.5%) in effect at the time of check-out plus \$2.00 TPA.

Staff Rooms: Group will have 5 staff rooms at \$99.00 per night.

COMMISSION

The group room rates listed above are 10% commissionable to Conference Planning Services IATA # 06-78196-1. Prince Hall Masons will advise its designated agency of these rates and address any resulting agency compensation issues directly with the management of the appropriate agency.

METHOD OF RESERVATIONS

Reservations for the Event will be made by the individual directly on ResLink, the customized event booking platform provided by the Hotel.

GUARANTEED RESERVATIONS

All reservations must be accompanied by a first night room deposit or guaranteed with a major credit card or by Prince Hall Masons. Hotel will not hold any reservations unless secured by one of the above methods.

CUT-OFF DATE

Reservations by attendees must be received on or before **June 16, 2026**, (the "Cut-Off Date"). At the Cut-Off Date, Hotel will review the reservation pick up for the Event, release the unreserved rooms for general sale, and determine whether or not it can accept reservations based on a space- and rate-available basis at the Prince Hall Masons group rate after this date.

RESERVATIONS

Rates to apply four (4) days pre and post contracted meeting dates. Occupied rooms will be applied towards total room pick-up for room attrition and commission. Reservation requests after the cutoff date will be provided at the contracted Group rate, including requests above the contracted Group room block. Early departure and no show fees will be applied towards any attrition charges. Should a Group attendee make reservations outside the official Group block, regardless of the rate or method of booking, any and all applicable room night credits will be applied towards total room pick-up for attrition and commission.

NO WALK CLAUSE

The Hotel agrees that all Group guests shall have priority accommodations over other guests, with no Group guests being "walked" (relocated) in the event of overbooking. If the Hotel fails to honor this commitment, it will cover all costs for equivalent or superior alternate accommodations, including transportation, accommodation at the alternate property at the contracted rate or higher. The Hotel will notify the Group's designated representative immediately if any situation arises that may impact the Group's reservation.

NO ROOM TRANSFER BY GUEST

Prince Hall Masons agrees that neither Prince Hall Masons nor attendees of the Event nor any intermediary shall be permitted to assign any rights or obligations under this Group Sales Agreement, or to resell or otherwise transfer to persons not associated with Prince Hall Masons reservations for guestrooms, meeting rooms or any other facilities made pursuant to this Group Sales Agreement.

BILLING ARRANGEMENTS

PAYMENT

Group will pay deposit of \$5,000 by April 10, 2026 via credit card. Remaining Master Account balance will be paid via Direct Bill pending approval.

All meeting rooms, food and beverage, and related services are subject to applicable taxes (currently 10.1%) and service charge (currently 24%) in effect on the date(s) of the Event. The Hotel reserves the right to adjust function space in direct proportion to any changes in the number of attendees. All changes to the meeting space must be approved by the Prince Hall Masons in writing.

DAMAGE TO FUNCTION SPACE

Prince Hall Masons agrees to pay for any damage to the function space that occurs while Prince Hall Masons is using it. Prince Hall Masons will not be responsible, however, for ordinary wear and tear or for damage that it can show was caused by persons other than Prince Hall Masons and its attendees.

ROOMS ATTRITION – Rooms Per Night

Hotel is relying upon Prince Hall Masons nightly use of the Room Night Commitment and, if applicable, the Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue. Prince Hall Masons agrees that a loss will be incurred by Hotel if Prince Hall Masons actual usage is less than 80% of the Cumulative Room Night Commitment.

Hotel agrees to allow for a 20% reduction in the cumulative Room Night Commitment across all contracted nights of the Event. At the conclusion of the Event, Hotel will calculate the total number of actual room nights utilized (excluding staff and/or complimentary rooms) and compare it to 80% of the total contracted Room Night Commitment. If actual usage falls below this threshold, the shortfall will be multiplied by the group’s average room rate (excluding staff and/or complimentary rooms), and the resulting amount will be posted as attrition charges to the Prince Hall Masons Master Account, plus applicable taxes.

Additionally, at the conclusion of the Event, if the actual banquet food and beverage revenue is less than the Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue, forty percent (40%) of the difference will be posted to the Master Account.

These charges represent a reasonable effort on behalf of the Hotel to establish its loss prospectively and shall be due as liquidated damages.

MINIMUM BANQUET FOOD AND BEVERAGE REVENUE REQUIREMENT

Prince Hall Masons agrees to a minimum banquet food and beverage revenue of \$20,000, exclusive of tax and service charge (the “Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue”). Prince Hall Masons shall provide Hotel with 14 days advance notice of the date(s), time(s), and number of covers with respect to each function it wishes to schedule for the Event.

CANCELLATION

In the event of a group cancellation occurring 0 to 29 business days prior to arrival, liquidated damages in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Room Night Commitment and seventy percent (70%) of the Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue will be due, plus applicable taxes.

In the event of a group cancellation occurring 30 business days to 90 days prior to arrival, liquidated damages in the amount of sixty percent (60%) of the Room Night Commitment and thirty percent (30%) of the Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue will be due, plus applicable taxes.

In the event of a group cancellation occurring 91 to 180 days prior to arrival, liquidated damages in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the Room Night Commitment and twenty five percent (25%) of the Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue will be due, plus applicable taxes.

In the event of a group cancellation occurring 181 to 365 days prior to arrival, no liquidated damages for either the Room Night Commitment or the Minimum Banquet Food and Beverage Revenue will be due.

IMPOSSIBILITY

The performance of this Agreement is subject to termination without liability upon the occurrence of any circumstance beyond the control of either party – such as acts of God, war, acts of terrorism, government regulations, epidemic or pandemic, disaster, strikes, civil disorder, or curtailment of transportation facilities – to the extent that such circumstance makes it illegal, impossible, or impractical for the Hotel to provide, or for groups in general to use, the Hotel facilities. The ability to terminate this Agreement without liability pursuant to this paragraph is conditioned upon delivery of written notice to the other party setting forth the basis for such termination as soon as reasonably practical - but in no event longer than twenty (20) days - after learning of such basis. The Hotel will refund any deposits or advance payments made by the Client within [30] days of the termination notice, less only those reasonable costs incurred directly for the event that cannot be mitigated.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Hotel shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Client, its officers, employees, and agents from all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including attorney's fees) arising from the Hotel's failure to meet its obligations under this Agreement; any injury or property damage caused by the Hotel's negligence or misconduct; any breach of the Hotel's representations; or any health or safety incidents occurring on the premises during the Client's event, except where caused by the Client's negligence. This indemnification shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

CONSTRUCTION

In the event of planned or ongoing construction, the Hotel will promptly inform the Group and make every effort to minimize disruption. Should construction impact meeting space, guest rooms, or other services, the Hotel will arrange comparable accommodations at a nearby property, cover any related transportation costs, and reduce the Group's liability for affected areas of the contract. If the Group does not find the proposed alternative accommodations acceptable, the Group shall have the option to cancel the contract and receive a full refund without liability. The Group reserves the right to renegotiate concessions, and if construction significantly disrupts the Event, the Group may cancel the contract without liability.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

This Agreement is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, including health and safety codes, alcoholic beverage control laws, disability laws, federal anti-terrorism laws and regulations, and the like. Hotel and Prince Hall Masons agree to cooperate with each other to ensure compliance with such laws.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, STIPULATIONS, OR LINING OUT

Any changes, additions, stipulations or deletions including corrective lining out by either Hotel or Prince Hall Masons will not be considered agreed to or binding on the other unless such modifications have been initialed or otherwise approved in writing by the other.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event of dispute resolution, the non-prevailing party will pay the other's costs and attorney's fees.

LIQUOR LICENSE

Prince Hall Masons understands that Hotel's liquor license requires that beverages only be dispensed by Hotel employees or bartenders. Alcoholic beverage service may be denied to those guests who appear to be intoxicated or are underage.

COMPLIANCE WITH EQUAL OPPORTUNITY LAWS

This section describes Marriott's obligations as a U.S. federal contractor. It does not apply to customers that are not part of

the U.S. federal government or using funds from the U.S. federal government for this contract.

Marriott shall comply with all applicable laws, statutes, rules, ordinances, codes, orders and regulations of all federal, state, local and other governmental and regulatory authorities and of all insurance bodies applicable to the Hotel premises in performing its obligations under this Agreement.

Marriott (referred to as “contractor” in this section) shall comply with Executive Order 11246, as amended, Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and the Vietnam Era Veterans’ Readjustment Assistance Act, as amended, which are administered by the United States Department of Labor (“DOL”), Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (“OFCCP”). The equal employment opportunity clauses of the implementing regulations, including but not limited to 41 C.F.R. §§ 60.1-4, 60-300.5(a), and 60-741.5(a), are hereby incorporated by reference, with all relevant rules, regulations and orders pertaining thereto. **This contractor and subcontractor shall abide by the requirements of 41 C.F.R. §§ 60-1.4(a), 60-300.5(a) and 60-741.5(a). These regulations prohibit discrimination against qualified individuals based on their status as protected veterans or individuals with disabilities, and prohibit discrimination against all individuals based on their race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin. Moreover, these regulations require that covered prime contractors and subcontractors take affirmative action to employ and advance in employment individuals without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, protected veteran status or disability.**

Marriott also shall comply with Executive Order 13496 and with all relevant rules, regulations and orders pertaining thereto, to the extent applicable. The employee notice clause and all other provisions of 29 C.F.R. Part 471, Appendix A to Subpart A, are hereby incorporated by reference.

To the extent applicable, Marriott shall include the provisions of this section in every subcontract or purchase order so that such provisions shall be binding upon each contractor, subcontractor or vendor performing services or providing materials relating to this Agreement and the services provided pursuant to the terms hereof.

PRIVACY

Marriott International, Inc. (“Marriott”) is committed to complying with obligations applicable to Marriott under applicable privacy and data protection laws, including to the extent applicable EU data protection laws. Hotel shall comply with the then-current Marriott Group Global Privacy Statement (the “Privacy Statement,” currently available at <http://www.marriott.com/about/privacy.mi>) with respect to any personal data received under this Agreement.

Without limiting the foregoing obligation, Hotel has implemented measures designed to: (1) provide notice to individuals about its collection and use of their personal data, including through the Privacy Statement; (2) use such personal data only for legitimate business purposes; (3) provide means by which individuals may request to review, correct, update, suppress, restrict or delete or port their personal data, consistent with applicable law; (4) require any service providers with whom personal data is shared to protect the confidentiality and security of such data; and (5) use technical and organizational measures to protect personal data within its organization against unauthorized or unlawful access, acquisition, use, disclosure, loss, or alteration.

Prince Hall Masons will obtain all necessary rights and permissions prior to providing any personal data to Hotel, including all rights and permissions required for Hotel, Hotel affiliates, and service providers to use and transfer the personal data to locations both within and outside the point of collection (including to the United States) in accordance with Hotel’s privacy statement and applicable law. Notwithstanding any other provision, Hotel may use an individual’s own personal data to the extent directed by, consented to or requested by such individual.

IN-HOUSE EQUIPMENT

Hotel will provide, at no charge, a reasonable amount of meeting equipment (for example, chairs, tables, etc.). These complimentary arrangements do not include special setups or extraordinary formats that would deplete Hotel’s present in-house equipment to the point of requiring rental of an additional supply to accommodate Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge Free & Accepted Masons of Washington (MWPGLWA)’s needs. If such special setups or extraordinary formats are requested, Hotel will present Prince Hall Masons two (2) alternatives: (1) charging Prince Hall Masons the rental cost for additional equipment, or (2) changing the extraordinary setup to a standard format, avoiding the additional cost.

TECHNICAL SERVICES

Live Oak is Hotel’s preferred provider for audio/visual needs.

UNATTENDED ITEMS/ADDITIONAL SECURITY

The Hotel cannot ensure the security of items left unattended in function rooms. Special arrangements may be made with the Hotel for securing a limited number of valuable items. If Prince Hall Masons requires additional security with respect to such items or for any other reason, the Hotel will assist in making these arrangements. All security personnel to be utilized during the Event are subject to Hotel approval.

USE OF OUTSIDE VENDORS

If Prince Hall Masons wishes to hire outside vendors to provide any goods or services at Hotel during the Event, Prince Hall Masons must notify Hotel of the specific goods or services to be provided and provide sufficient advance notice to the Hotel so that the Hotel can (i) determine, in Hotel’s sole discretion, whether such vendor must provide Hotel, in form and amount reasonably satisfactory to Hotel, an indemnification agreement and proof of adequate insurance, and (ii) approve, using reasonable judgment, the selection of the outside vendor and the goods or services to be provided by such outside vendor to Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge Free & Accepted Masons of Washington (MWPHGLWA), taking into consideration: (a) whether Hotel offers such goods and services; (b) the risk level posed by certain activities; and (c) the safety and well-being of guests at Hotel.

PERFORMANCE LICENSES

Prince Hall Masons will be solely responsible for obtaining any necessary licenses or permission to perform, broadcast, transmit, or display any copyrighted works (including without limitation, music, audio, or video recordings, art, etc.) that Prince Hall Masons may use or request to be used at the Hotel.

MARRIOTT BONVOY EVENTS

Marriott Bonvoy Events provides Points or Miles to eligible Marriott Bonvoy Members who book and hold qualifying meetings and events at Participating Properties.

Approximately ten (10) business days after the conclusion of the Event (provided that the Event is not cancelled and Prince Hall Masons has otherwise complied with the material terms and conditions of this Agreement), the Hotel will award Points or Miles to the Member and relevant account identified below. By inserting the airline frequent flyer account information, the recipient elects to receive Miles instead of Points.

HIGH RISK ACTIVITIES

Should Hotel, in its sole reasonable discretion, determine at any time that the Event will include a high-risk activity that was previously undisclosed to the Hotel (including by way of example, and not by limitation, biological agents, pyrotechnics, etc.), Hotel may terminate this Agreement immediately and without liability, upon written notice to Prince Hall Masons

ACCEPTANCE

When presented by the Hotel to Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge Free & Accepted Masons of Washington (MWPHGLWA), this document is an invitation by the Hotel to Prince Hall Masons to make an offer. Upon signature by Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge Free & Accepted Masons of Washington (MWPHGLWA), this document will be an offer by Prince Hall Masons Only upon signature of this document by all parties will this document constitute a binding agreement. Unless the Hotel otherwise notifies Prince Hall Mason sat any time prior to Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge Free & Accepted Masons of Washington (MWPHGLWA)’s execution of this document, the outlined format and dates will be held by the Hotel for Prince Hall Masons a a first-option basis until **August 22, 2025**. If Prince Hall Masons cannot make a commitment prior to that date, this invitation to offer will revert to a second-option basis or, at the Hotel’s option, the arrangements will be released, in which case neither party will have any further obligations.

Upon signature by both parties, Prince Hall Masons and the Hotel shall have agreed to and executed this Agreement by their authorized representatives as of the dates indicated below.
