3. ALL RULES, POLICIES AND PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF THE DRILL MEET WILL THE PROCEDURES OUTLINED IN SIXTH BRIGADE STATE DRILL MOI INCLUDING DRILL SEQUENCE SHEETS. PLEASE INSURE YOU HAVE THE LATEST 6TH BDE MOI ANNEX AND TC-3-21.5. WE WILL NOT DEVIATE FROM THE BDE MOI. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THE MOI, LET ME KNOW AND I WILL SEND YOU A COPY.

4. There is no scheduled break for lunch during the meet. A concession stand will be operational throughout the meet and fast-food outlets are located nearby.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Osborne High School meet will mirror the 6th BDE MOI.

ENTRANCE FEE: \$100.00. Mail to: Osborne High School JROTC, ATTN: CW4 Rodney Fagan, 2451 Favor Road, Marietta, GA 30060 or hand carry to the meet.

TIME, LOCATION AND DRILL AREA: All Drill Team Commanders or their representatives need to report directly to the control table upon arrival. Competition will begin promptly at 0900 hours when the first team reports to the ready area. Please plan to arrive NLT 0800 hrs. Awards ceremony at 1500. A rotation schedule will be provided later. ALL EVENTS MUST BE COMPLETED BY 1430. BOXES WILL CLOSE AT 1430.

There will be two meetings beginning at 0830, Judges and coaches.

Directions: Use address 2451 Kennedy Lane SW, Marietta 30060 to get you to the rear of the school. Cadets will be posted along the routes of approach to guide you to the event area.

- a. WEAPONS STORAGE: Weapons security is the responsibility of the individual unit. No secure weapon storage will be provided.

UNIFORMS: All cadets will wear only the Army issued JROTC the Class A uniform or ASU with authorized accessories (to include rank, nameplate, and ribbons) -- nameplates must be worn during all competition events. Authorized accessories are scarves, solid white or solid black gloves (with full fingers) for regulation drill and exhibition drill. Additionally, Color Guard may wear white, green, blue or black belts and harnesses.

- b. JUDGES: Judges will be SAI/AI, Army National Guard, and NGCSU cadets if available. Please help us have a good meet by providing a judge. I would like to have an SAI/AI as head judge for all events except exhibition. Uniform is OCP or Class B.
- c. WEAPONS: Rifles for the Armed Division will be US Rifle Cal., M-1; US Rifle Cal., M1903, US Rifle.
- d. PARKING: Parking will be available at the rear of the school by the football field.
- e. COMPLAINTS: All complaints must be registered with the Drill Meet OIC, CW4 Fagan, by the Cadet Commander /Team Instructor **ONLY**. Please make every attempt to resolve any issues with

the head judge before leaving the area but please do not argue with the judges. **PLEASE KEEP IT PROFESSIONAL. CADETS ARE WATCHING.**

1. **SCORING: The sequence for Regulation and Color Guard will be the same as Sixth Brigade Score sheets.** TC 3-21.5 will be used for Regulation Drill/Color Guard. Sequences must be memorized in order and no assistance will be given to the drill team commander once the competition begins. Please use the CURRENT BDE sequence sheet from the MOI.
2. **TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES:** All ties will be broken by the results of the head judge's score sheet. If a tie still remains, the highest judge's score will be dropped, and the scores recalculated, and the highest recalculated score will be the winner.
3. **Eligibility:** A cadet may only compete in one category in like events. Male cadets cannot compete in female events. Female cadets may participate in either category of events but cannot do the same event in both categories, i.e. she cannot COMPETE IN M/M Unarmed Squad and Female Unarmed Squad.
4. **Knockout Drill (Unarmed)** will be conducted if time allows. Each cadet competing will pay a fee of \$1.00.

6. **AWARDS:** The following awards will be presented: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards to the teams with the highest scores in this category.
 - a. **COLOR GUARD:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards to the teams with the highest scores in this category.
 - b. **OVERALL:** There will not be overall awards.

- d. A cadet may compete in all events in Category 1 or Category 2 or a combination of both. However, a cadet CAN NOT compete in like events in both categories. **You must email the events you will be competing in not later than 1 February 2020.** This is essential in order to finalize judge/ evaluator requirements, trophy requirements, and scheduling of events for each school.
- e. Cadets may compete in Knockout Drill (Armed) and (Unarmed). Knockout drill will be open to all cadets at the meet at a cost of \$1.00 for Armed and \$1.00 for Unarmed. Tickets will be sold at the concession stand and collected at the entrance to the field prior to the start of knockout competitions.
- f. Male cadets MUST compete in only Male/Mix events; females may compete in either. Females competing in Male/Mix events MUST use standard weight drill rifles. Coaches are responsible for monitoring their own teams and individuals for compliance.
- g. The 'Description of Events', 'Drill Field Layout', and 'Event Score Sheets' will be the same as those outlined in Sixth Brigade MOI Annex C, D, E. Be sure to review these closely.
