SUBJECT: Letter of Instruction (LOI) for the Mary Persons High School (MPHS) Raider Meet 27 September 2025

**PURPOSE:** Announcement of the first MPHS Raider meet to be held at the MPHS Main Campus in Forsyth GA and provide overview of the events stations and locations. At this time the MPHS Raider meet will be limited to only AJROTC Area 12 schools. (If more space and resources become available, an announcement for more teams will be sent out.)

**SCOPE:** The MPHS Raider Meet Competition is being held to:

- 1. Provide a third venue in the Middle GA Area for qualification for State Raider competitions.
- 2. Promote competition spirit and interaction between local Raider and JROTC programs.
- 3. Develop teamwork, physical fitness, and self-esteem among cadets in the JROTC program.
- 1. General Information: The MHS JROTC Raider meet, "Raider Rumble", will begin at 0830 on 27 SEP 2025 in front of the MPHS High school located at 300 Montpelier Ave Forsyth GA 31029. The Raider Rumble will consist of 5 events beginning with a 2.2 mile run, then rotating through a half mile Cross Country Rescue, Tire Flip, Rope Bridge, and Obstacle Course. Competition events are expected to end by 1400. Snack concessions will be on site.
- 2. Entrants / Teams: Due to resource and space constraints, entries for the Raider Rumble will be limited to Area 12 JROTC programs initially. If space become available, additional slots may be opened. Teams will be allowed in 3 categories; Male, Female, and Mix (4 females must start each event). Programs will be allowed one team per category as priority. If space is available, additional teams per school will be allowed. Maximum number of team for the Raider Rumble will be 25. Teams will consist of 12 tagged competitors with 10 starters per event. Teams who cannot field 10 cadets at the start line may continue but will be disqualified from team and those event awards.
- 3. Events: The Raider Rumble will begin with a 2 mile run through the MPHS\Central office campus driveway system. The course will be closed to vehicle traffic. Cadets will stage at the lower level front parking lot following the course outlined in Annex A. Teams will then rotate through assigned start points for the remainder events. The tire flip will be held on the field area of the track located south of the school building. The rope bridge will be held in the area between the track and ball field. CCR will start in the south corner of the East parking area next to the creek. The Obstacle course is located off campus I mile south at the old JROTC campus (Annex B). A shuttle bus will be provided to move teams to the Obstacle Course all day. Shuttle drop/pickup point will be at the Northeast corner of the East parking lot at the loop.



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


- **4. Weather:** Prepare accordingly for fall GA weather. In case of dangerous weather condition, the meet may be delayed. If sheltered area is needed, all participants will move to the MPHS Gym which is on the south side of the Main Campus building. (When facing building, far right doors.) Weather call will be continued horn blast from C2 trailer.
- **5. Command and Control:** C2 trailer will be in the parking area at the north end of the track. SAI for the Raider Rumble is MAJ Jacob Dunn (678.207.7577). MPHS AI is CSM Chris DuBose.
- **6. Vehicle Parking:** All vehicles should enter the MPHS campus from Montpelier Ave. Teams will park in the West parking area in front of the school (Annex B) Overflow parking is at the Tennis Court parking off Montpelier. No parking is allowed in the East parking lot due to us as staging area for the run and CCR.
- 7. Medical: Report all medical issues and injuries/problems to the NCOIC/OIC via the C2 trailer. SIA/AI are responsible for Serious Incident Reports (SIRS) will be submitted to MPHS C2 trailer before departing the meet. Each school will be responsible for evaluating, treating or transporting injured cadets. The local hospital is 2 miles away for self Evac (Annex C), serious injury use 911. The event cadre will contact the Bulldog Invitational OIC or NCOIC who will call 911. An adult school representative from the injured cadet's school must ride in the ambulance with the cadet to the hospital. MPHS JROTC cadets will be present as runners across the event areas designated in Yellow MP PT shirt. Any message needing to be immediately sent to C2 trailer can use MPHS runners.
- **8. Registration:** Registration email will be sent out first week of AUG. Reg fee will be \$75 for first team \$100 for 2 or more. Reservations suspense for a reserve slot will be 01SEP2025. Any Area 12 school that is interested in participating in this event, please send an email to reserve a slot. Any non-Area 12 school that is interested in attending, please send your information and you will be placed on the wait list until 01 SEP 2025
- **9. Updates:** This LOI will be updated in August as additional information is finalized. Final instructions will be published 02SEP2025 and will include announcements of additional team slots. Standard grading for events, grade sheets will be included in final LOI


