

# General info

- All Buses can park on Mansfield St (GA Campus)
- Team tent setup area is in the grass area in between Mansfield St and the football field
- In the event of rain, competition continues. If severe weather, all teams will move to the fieldhouse adjacent to the football field
- Teams should be prepared to treat minor injuries first. In the event there is a significant injury, EMS will be notified by the event HQ
- In the event there is a discrepancy with the scoring, notify HQ prior to signing scoresheet. Do not argue with the official. Any unsportsmanlike conduct from cadets, coaches, or parents may result in event DQ
- Restrooms are located at the field house



# Team Run


- 1<sup>st</sup> event for all teams
- Uniform is ACU/MARPAT trousers, team shirt, and running shoes or boots (not recommended)
- Male teams, Mixed, then Female per school
- Teams not required to stay together, however, 10-meter box at the end
- Sidewalk around perimeter and surrounding area
- Teams finishing with 9 = 5-minute penalty; 8 or less = DQ (7/6 for Females)
- No carrying teammates or profanity



# Raider Fitness Course


- 400-meter event held on football field
- All 10 members run the course down and back
- Uniform is ACU/BDU/MARPAT trousers, team shirt, and boots
- Male teams, Mixed, then Female per school
- All gear must pass line and remain upright during equipment carry
- Tractor tires (x2) 1–2-person lift
- Raiders must attempt each tire in tire dance
- **All 10 members must touch canoe before movement**
- Single file in agility maze
- No dropping/throwing gear (30-second penalty per occurrence)

# Cross-Country Resupply

- 1-mile course over grass and pavement
- 4 rucks (35lbs), 2 Ammo Crates, 1 (20lb) Wall Ball
- Uniform is ACU/BDU/MARPAT trousers, team shirt, and boots
- Male teams, Mixed, then Female per school
- Teams not required to stay together; however, team members that cross finish cannot return. All gear staged at finish line MUST have a gear guard.
- Teams will start on the 8ft Wall. Rucks, Crates, and Wall Ball will be staged on opposite side of wall.
- No dropping/throwing gear – 30-second penalty per occurrence

# **Rope Bridge**

- Standard Rope Bridge IAW USACC Army Nationals SOPs
- Telephone poles
  - 60ft – All Teams
- Minimum Rope Length 120ft
- Steel locking or opposing gate for near side transport tightening system
- No more than (3) Raiders clipped on rope at a time
- Feet / hands/back cannot assist crossing

# Ultimate Raider

1. Uniform for the event will be ACU/MARPAT, team T-shirt, and boots.
3. Each team can nominate (2) cadets to participate in the event as a team.
4. Each cadet competing MUST have participated in each event of the regular competition.
5. The competition will begin with the team Tire flip of 50 yards.
6. Upon completion of the tire flip, the team will complete a run/ruck of a 1/2 mile lap around the perimeter carrying (2) ALICE packs weighing 35lbs
7. To finish, the team will low-crawl for a distance of 20 yards to the finish line.
