### 4x4 Beach Access & Marine Recreational Registry Information:

NOTICE: NY STATE 4X4 AND CAMP HERO PERMITS REQUIRE YOU HAVE A VALID NYSDEC MARINE RECREATIONAL REGISTRY LICENSE TO OBTAIN THE BEACH ACCESS PERMITS.

## **Suffolk County 4×4 Beach Access Permit**

The NYSDEC Marine Recreational Registry License is not a requirement for the Suffolk County 4×4 Beach Access permits. For the County permit you need your County Parks Green Key and current vehicle registration card. However, it appears that previous policy with the County Parks employee issuing the sticker witnessing you putting the sticker on your vehicle is not in effect currently. County Access Permit goes to half price after Labor Day. Senior's (over 60) cost is ½ (\$50) for the entire year.

#### NY STATE 4X4 AND CAMP HERO DASHBOARD PERMITS

NY State 4x4 and Camp Hero Dashboard Permits are now available the day after Labor Day 9/3/24. The permits are available on-line or by phone only.

## 2024 Long Island 4x4 and Camp Hero Dashboard Permits

4x4 Fishing, 4x4 Surfing, Stargazing, Night/Sport Fishing, Camp Hero Fishing, Regional SCUBA-Diving, Nighttime Photography, Metal Detecting

Permit(s) may be purchased ONLY ONLINE or by PHONE and will be mailed once processed. Please allow at least 14 business days for your physical permit(s) to arrive in the mail.

The following is required to purchase a 2024 Long Island Dashboard Permit: Valid Reserve America account log in - needed for ONLINE and PHONE sales only. Valid e-mail address

- Valid credit card is required for payment
- Valid driver's license of the applicant
- Valid vehicle registration and license plate information
- Valid NYS DEC Recreational Saltwater/Marine Fishing Registry ID # (required for <u>fishing</u> dashboard permits only).
- "C" card (required for Regional SCUBA-Diving only)

You must have an existing or create a new Reserve America account with a valid email address

- Select the permit(s) you wish to purchase and complete the required information
- Add to cart and follow prompts to complete purchase
- Please allow 14 business days for your physical permit(s) to be issued and arrive in the mail

Remember to obtain your 2025 NY State Recreational Marine Registry License for salt water fishing.

The Registration now goes from the date issued for 12 months (not January to December by default any more). The license is free.

Also, they can be easily obtained at Dick's Sporting Goods in Riverhead and Southold Town Clerk's office. Your NY Marine Registry License is reciprocal with Connecticut and Rhode Island.



## **NY State Surf Fishing Contest**

Reminder: Begins 12 AM on April 15<sup>th</sup> and ends midnight November 30<sup>th</sup>. NOTICE: The NY Surf Fishing Contest requires all scales to be certified. Please bring your scales to the meeting to have them certified. You cannot submit fish caught until your scale is certified unless fishing with a Club member with a certified scale.

Your catch information needs to be submitted to me by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the next month by on our website or in person with physical slips (if necessary) at our club meeting. The data must include the species, weight, date and where (in general) caught and if released. If multiple fish of a species are caught in a single day, you can list additional fish information on the digital "slip" on the website (It has provision for multiple fish on the same day) or on the back of the slip (if necessary), with all necessary information. This contest is totally the honor system. Witnessing is only necessary for the heaviest of a species, but all fish must be weighed on your certified scale or another member's certified scale if necessary. The weights for scale certification are available at every meeting.

#### **CRITERIA:**

Minimum weights for contest purposes are Striped Bass - 10 lbs., Bluefish - 5 lbs., Weakfish - 5 lbs. Any Striped Bass not released CANNOT be submitted. The ten heaviest bass, bluefish and weakfish (Top Ten) each month of all fish for each species reported are tallied for Club standings and Individual standings. The balance of the three species fish is reported as released points plus the Top Ten released fish of each species equal total released points for the month.

The 2024 Contest Rules were emailed to members.
