- **Enoch** walked with God (Gen 5:22)
- **Noah** walked with God (Gen 6:9)
- **Abraham and Isaac** walked before God (Gen 48:15)
- God commanded **Israel** to walk in his statutes (Lev 26:3)
- The **psalmist** says “**blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked**” (Ps 1:1)
- **Micah** tells us to “**walk humbly**” with our God (Mic 6:8)

- **Paul** tells us to “**walk in newness of life**” (Rom 6:4)
- **Paul** tells us to “**walk by faith, not by sight**” (2 Cor 5:7)
- **Paul** tells us to “**walk by the Spirit**” (Gal 5:16)



Walk

◀ 4043 περιπατέω ▶

- *peripateó (per-ee-pat-eh'-o)*
- *to walk, to walk about, to behave*
- *I walk, hence I conduct my life, live.*

- “... live a life...” (AMP)
- “... lead a life...” (NLT)

Worthy

◀ 516 ἀξίως ▶

- *axiós* (*ax-ee'-oce*)
- *worthily, in a manner worthy of*
- *worthily* (viewed as “becoming”);
suitable because recognized as fitting
(having worth that “matches” actual
value)





How to walk / live in a manner worthy:

- Walking in **unity** (Eph 4:1-16)
- Walking in **purity** (Eph 4:17-32)
- Walking in **love** (Eph 5:1-6)
- Walking in **light** (Eph 5:7-14)
- Walking **carefully** (Eph 5:15-21)
- Walking **in this world** (Eph 5:22-6:24)

- Ephesians 1-3 is about sitting.
- Ephesians 4-6:9 is about walking.
- Ephesians 6:10-24 is about standing.

**The process of
discipleship is**

“Sit, Walk, Stand”

◀ 2821 κλήσις ▶

- *klésis (klay' -sis)*
- *a calling, invitation (always of a divine call)*
- *to call, summon*

- *oun (oon)*
- *therefore, then, (and) so*
- *here's how the dots connect.*
