Kingdom mindset vs church mindset:

Kingdom Mindset	Church Mindset
Releases all saints as ministers in the marketplace.	Trains people to serve in a church building on Sundays.
Embraces and loves the surrounding unchurched communities.	Embraces the converted individuals within their faith communities.
Trains people for all of life.	Trains people only for church life.

Kingdom mindset vs church mindset:

Kingdom Mindset

Nurtures leaders who are world changers and “culture creatives” who articulate truth to society.

Empowers mankind to dominate and influence the earth.

Church Mindset

Nurtures leaders who speak religious language relevant only to church people.

Prepares mankind to be holy and escape earth to heaven.

Story of the good samaritan (who is my neighbour?) - Luke 10:29-37

29 The man wanted to justify his actions, so he asked Jesus, “And **who is my neighbor?**”

30 Jesus replied with a story: “A Jewish man was traveling from Jerusalem down to Jericho, and he was attacked by bandits. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him up, and left him half dead beside the road.

Story of the good samaritan (who is my neighbour?) - Luke 10:29-37

31 “By chance a priest came along. But when he saw the man lying there, he crossed to the other side of the road and passed him by. **32** A Temple assistant walked over and looked at him lying there, but he also passed by on the other side. **33** “Then a despised Samaritan came along, and when he saw the man, he felt compassion for him.

Story of the good samaritan (who is my neighbour?) - Luke 10:29-37

34 Going over to him, the Samaritan soothed his wounds with olive oil and wine and bandaged them.

35 Then he put the man on his own donkey and took him to an inn, where he took care of him. The next day he handed the innkeeper two silver coins, telling him, 'Take care of this man. If his bill runs higher than this, I'll pay you the next time I'm here.'
