#### SUMMARY OF DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

- 1. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New testaments. We believe in the verbal, plenary inspiration of Scripture, and in the inerrancy of God's Word. The Bible is the supreme and final authority in all matters of faith, life and practice. Only any student or faculty member will use the King James Bible.
- 2. We believe in one God, eternally existent in three Persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 3. We believe in the virgin birth of Jesus Christ, His sinless life, vicarious death, bodily resurrection, literal return and absolute Deity.
