



Floatair Boatlift Warranty:

Notice: (Warranty is non-transferable) For warranty to be effective it must be registered with Manufacturer. Seven Seas Corporation warrants Floatair Boatlifts will be free of defective materials and workmanship for the following terms:

- 1) Floatair offers a Lifetime warranty to the original purchaser on rotomolded lift tanks are warranted against manufacturer defect for the lifetime of the original owner.
- 2) Switches, motors and electrical components (except remote control unit) are warranted against manufacturer defect for two (2) years.
- 3) All other components of the Floatair lift are warranted against manufacturer defect for five (5) years from the date of installation. The front mount frame is warranted for ten (10) years from the installation date to the original purchaser. **Claims must be made to an authorized Floatair Dealer or Seven Seas Corporation within thirty (30) days after any defect is first discovered.** Manufacturer will make the final determination as to whether the product is covered under terms of the warranty.

Manufacturer's responsibility is limited, at Manufacturer's option, to replace or repair the defective product (**Labor Excluded**). Manufacturer will not be liable for: loss of profits, loss of savings, or revenue; loss of the lift or any associated equipment; cost of capital; cost of any substitute equipment facilities or services; downtime; the claims of third parties including customers; injury to property; and in no event will Manufacturer be liable for any incidental, consequential, or absolutely any type of damages.

The following conditions must be followed or the warranty may be voided at the option of Manufacturer:

- 1) Must prep boat and tie boat up safely and securely to dock in event your lift does go down.
- 2) This warranty does not cover abuse, misuse, or acts of nature of any type.
- 3) Installation, modifications, maintenance, repairs and service must be performed by an authorized dealer of the Manufacturer.
- 4) Boat must be balanced correctly on lift when raising lift and/or left in raised/store position.
- 5) Boatlift must be in upright position if the boat is left off for a period longer than one week, (Front Mount and Side Mount designs must not be over raised when left in upright position.)
- 6) Wake boats must **NEVER** be lifted with water in the ballast tanks or water bladders. Failure to completely drain all ballast before lifting may result in lift damage. Damage caused by lifting a boat with ballast water onboard is not covered under the Floatair warranty.
