## Joie de français: Beginners course

### Joie de travail: French for business

This course is designed specifically for individuals or business that need to use French for corporate

purposes. It is best attended by a group of employees from your business (I can to you if this is the case), as the course can be tailored to the language needs of your particular industry. The lessons are booked in blocks of 4 and in general, will cover:
