May 21 General Primary & Nonpartisan Election

In April, trained SCC volunteers will visit Cobb County Senior Services Department senior centers, sharing information about upcoming May elections and reminding seniors to create a voting

plan. In addition to deciding which of 3 ways to vote - by mail, in person at an advance voting location, or in person on Election Day - it's important to register to vote by April 22 and check My Voter Page at My Voter Page. This website includes your basic voter information, plus sample ballots, in person voting locations, absentee ballot dropbox locations, voter ID requirements, and much more. personal property records are filed with, indexed, and data is transmitted by Clerks of Superior Court throughout the state of Georgia.

Household leaks are more prevalent than you might realize. Worn toilet flappers, dripping faucets, and other leaking valves are simple to fix and can reduce your water bill. Cobb County
