 From Cobb Courier: It's that time of year before Tax Day when we need to
 dispose of stacks of no longer needed records, but we want to do it in a
 way that avoids identity theft or other fraud. CLICK HERE for more

- It's that time of year again! Cobb EMC's HVAC Tuneup rebate program encourages our members to schedule annual pre-season checkups with a qualified contractor to check that HVAC systems are operating efficiently. A yearly tune-up is one of several steps that our members can take to increase the efficiency of their heating and cooling system. Vouchers are available beginning March 1, 2025, and will remain available while supplies last. CLICK HERE for more information

- Enhanced Standard Tax Deduction: For the 2025 tax year, seniors aged 65 or older will receive an increased standard deduction. Single filers or heads of household will get an additional \$2,000, while married couples filing jointly will receive an extra \$1,600 per spouse. CLICK HERE for more information.
- Updated Senior Citizen Discounts on Utilities: Georgia Power offers a
 monthly discount of \$24.00 plus up to \$9.50 fuel credit for eligible
 seniors. Liberty Utilities and Atlanta Gas Light provide discounts on
 the base charge portion of gas bills for qualifying seniors. CLICK
