- Speaker should use current presentation technology

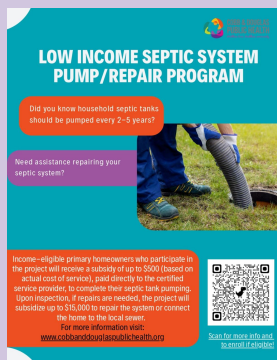
