The **40/8 Society**, formally known as *La Société des Quirante Hommes et Huit Chauvaux* (The Society of Forty Men and Eight Horses), is a unique and historic veterans' organization founded in 1920 by American Legionnaires.

The name "40/8" comes from **French WWI boxcars** that were stenciled with "40 Hommes/8 Chauvaux," meaning they could carry **40 men or 8 horses**. These cramped boxcars transported American troops to the front lines and became a symbol of shared hardship and camaraderie.

The upcoming October program will focus on **The Pact Act** and how it provides generations of veterans and survivors with care and benefits they've earned.
