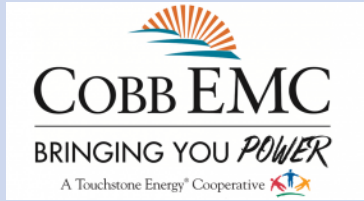
### FREE Caregiver Workshop from the Alzheimer's Association
