Church & Parish Announcements:

A big welcome to **Elsie Irene Krause** who is being baptized into our church family this morning! May God's grace guide and protect her.

Today we "Bury the Alleluia" from our worship, removing its joy from our lips for the next 40-odd days. We do this to draw us closer to the heart of Lent – Christ's sacrifice on our behalf. Our closing hymn today reflects this practice. Here are a couple of good quotes on why we do such:

"We desist from saying Alleluia, the song chanted by angels, because we have been excluded from the company of the angels on account of Adam's sin. In the Babylon of our earthly life we sit by the streams, weeping as we remember Sion. For as the children of Israel in an alien land hung their harps upon the willows, so we too must forget the Alleluia song in the season of sadness, of penance, and bitterness of heart."

"Thus the Alleluia is sung for the last time and not heard again until it suddenly bursts into glory during the Mass of the Easter Vigil when the celebrant intones this sacred word after the Epistle, repeating it three times, as a jubilant herald of the Resurrection of Christ."

Tuesday, March 4th is called "**Shrove Tuesday**," the day before Ash Wednesday when you are to prepare yourself for the coming season of Lent. While the world spends it in revelry and debauchery (think New Orleans & Mardi Gras), the Church does it in prayer (and maybe pancakes :-)). We will hold a Vespers service at St Paul where we will be burning last year's palms to prepare the ashes for the next day. Service will be from 5:15-5:45 pm.

The **Season of Lent** begins on Wed., March 5th, again holding services at St. Paul at 11a and Immanuel at 7p. This year we are participating in a round-robin with Circuit 13. The theme is "Faith in the Midst of Darkness." We will be holding a lunch/snack after worship at SP and dinner at IM. Please consider signing up to serve.
