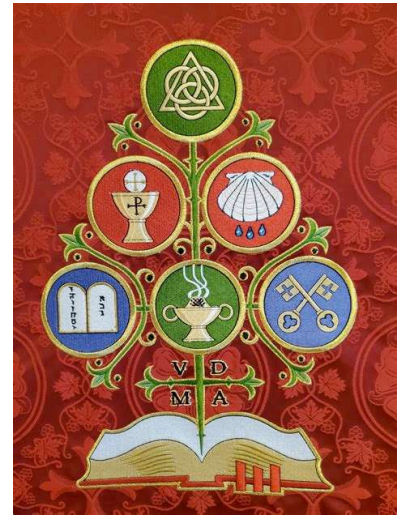

**Immanuel has decided to cancel this spring's annual Potato Pancake dinner in May.**

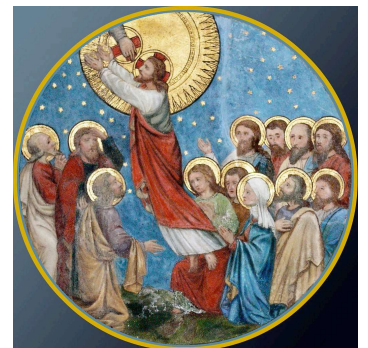
**Be sure to join us for our traditional Fall Dinner, Sunday, October 12**

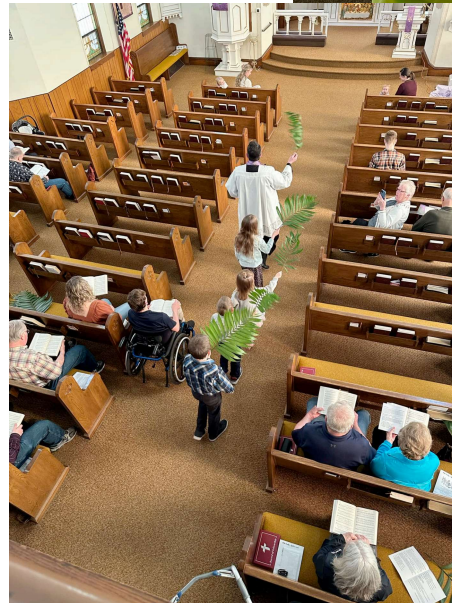
