The wildfires of California and devastation of Hurricane Helene seem just like yesterday as we think about natural disasters in the United States. For the people who lived through them the impact on their lives is a daily reminder of the loss they experienced as the vast majority will be dealing with the recovery for years to come. Since LCMS Disaster Response started with LERT (Lutheran Emergency Response Training) in 2005 after Hurricane Katrina hit New Orleans, it seems we have experienced an unprecedented number of storms. From earth shattering tornados that remove small rural towns in Central Illinois and Kentucky off the map to massive Hurricanes like Helene that bring wind and flood destruction across six states, North Wisconsin District congregations have been represented by hundreds of volunteers called to serve.
