At the May 18 special meeting, Immanuel voted to go ahead with installing A/C to the church (in order to install before federal regulations increase the cost). Out of 154, 74 responded, voting 43-31, with \$8655.88 pledged toward the \$10,000 cost. It was also voted to accept the bid of Five Star Roofing to put on a new steel roof to the church, at the cost of \$35,400.
