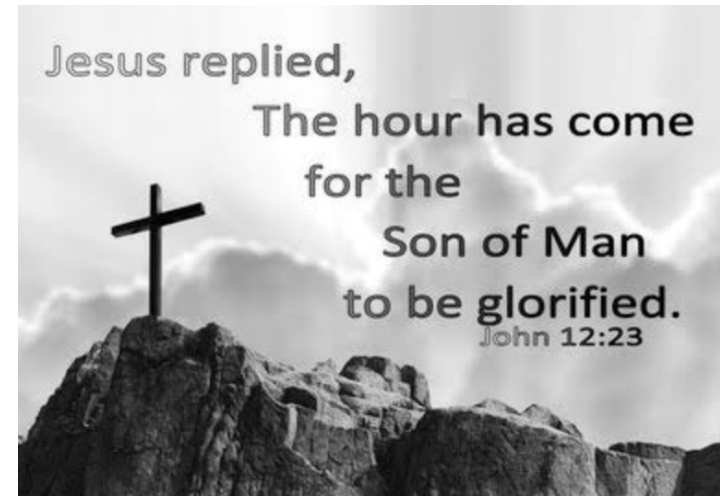
District Announcements:
