The North Wisconsin District of the LC-MS was in convention June 1-2 and we elected & called a new District President, Rev. Timothy Schoup, as Rev. Dwyane Lueck is retiring from active ministry. Other notable elections were Rev. Ryan Fehrmann (Region A), Rev. Don Engelbretson (Region B) & Rev. Preston Paul (Region C) were elected as Vice Presidents, with Rev. Engelbretson elected as 1st VP, Preston 2nd & Fehrmann 3rd. Rev. Travis Kleinschmidt was elected as District Secretary. Pastor Craig also began his 3-year term as District 14 Circuit Visitor.
