This Sunday we are celebrating **The Festival of St. Peter and St. Paul** – probably the oldest of the saints' observances (dating from about the middle of the third century). An early tradition held that these two pillars of the New Testament Church were martyred on the same day in Rome during the persecution under Nero. In addition to this joint commemoration of their deaths, both apostles are commemorated separately: Peter on Jan. 18 for his confession of Jesus as the Christ (Matthew 16:13-16) and Paul on Jan. 25 for his conversion (Acts 9:1-19).


