
### **District Announcements:**

Circuit Forum and Delegate Election: It is time for the circuit to vote on the clergy & lay delegates to the Synod Convention in July 2026. As a parish, Pastor Craig is eligible to stand for the clergy and someone from the parish is eligible to stand for the lay. If you are interested in having your name up for consideration on the ballot, speak to PC. Also, we will need 1 lay person from the parish to serve as the representative at the forum to vote (does not need to be a candidate on the ballot). This will be held at Immanuel on Sunday, Oct. 5th at 2 pm. If you are interested in this, please let PC know.
