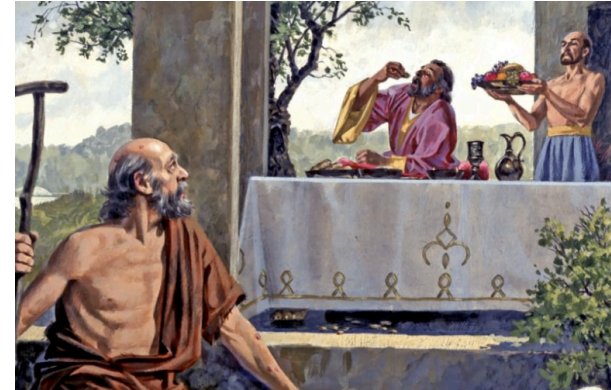
Community Announcements:
