Fellowship Sundays are back! Check the sign up in the Narthex to see the available dates.

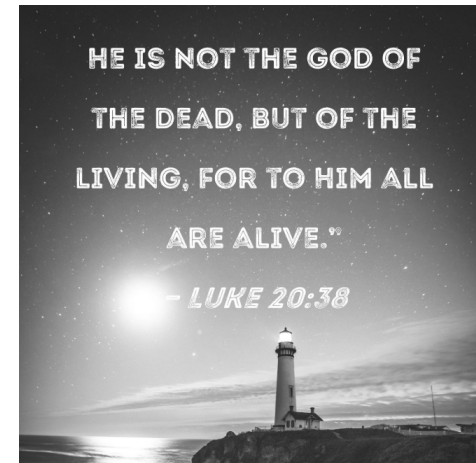
