As we are in the season of Lent, like last year we will be using the ashes from last years palms throughout, not just for a day. For the remembrance of our sin; that we are but dust because of them, are the only way will we understand and comprehend and hear the glorious news that we are forgiven, saved and redeemed from death by the work of redemption we receive in Christ.

So, there will be the plate of ashes as you enter the Nave and you are invited to make a cross in it each time you enter, so to remember why you have been called by the Spirit to come, hear and receive the good news of Christ.

To reflect the penitential nature of Lent, we begin each service in silence, rising as the pastor processes in, moving to the confession of sins in the Litany, followed by the opening hymn and collect.

TIME OF CONFESSION & REPENTANCE

P: In the Name of the Father, and of the ☩ Son, and of the Holy Spirit

C: Amen.

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

C: But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Litany (pew sheet)

P: Almighty God, in His mercy, has given His Son to die for you, and for His sake, forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained minister of the Church of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore declare to you the entire forgiveness of your sins, in the Name of the Father, and of the ☩ Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

Collect (sung by Pastor)

Lenten Verse (before Gospel): Return to the Lord, your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love.
